BEVINS, Solon A. 25 Feb 1864

Private Bevins was age 32 when he entered service. He was transferred to Co. E 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co B, 48th OVI on 24 July 1865. Mustered out 16 Apr 1866.

Father?: Ira Bevans was listed in the 1840 Census in Mohican Twp, Wayne Co OH with 8 persons. Ira is buried at [Nashville Cemetery, Holmes Co OH](#). He died in 1844. Sons William and Corwin are also buried there.

Marriages, Ashland County, Ohio by Nellie M Raber: Solon A BEVENS married Augusta C GRAHAM on 25 Nov 1858 in Ashland Co OH.

1860 Census, City of Red Wing, Goodhue County, MN, page 486: H L BEVANS, age 38 OH, merchant; Julia, age 34 OH; Mary, age 14 WI; Amelia HANSON, age 20 Norway, domestic; [second family in the dwelling] Solon A BEVANS, age 28 OH, merchant; Augusta C, age 23 OH; Frank, age 1 MN.

Wife, Ohio Deaths: Augusta BEVINS died Feb 1869 at Ashland, Ashland Co OH.

Augusta C. Graham Bevans: Buried at Ashland Cemetery, Ashland Co OH. Spouse of S. A. BEVANS. 1837-1869.

1870 Census, Town of Bloomfield, Davis County, IA, page 6: Solon A BEAVINS, age 36 OH, clerk in dry goods store.

1880 Census, Series: T9 Roll: 111, Bijou Hills, Brule County, Dakota Territory, page 194: S. A. BEVINS, age 47 OH, employee, widowed, occupation not legible, father born MA, mother born PA? [Note: I think the man who had the employees was a stock raiser, but it is hard to read.]

1880 US National Homes for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers, Dayton, Montgomery Co OH, Central Branch: Solon A. BEVANS, enlisted 23 Feb 1862 at Cincinnati in 71st OH Vols. discharged at Columbus Oh as a paroled prisoner. Enlisted 25 Feb 1864 in Co B 120th OH Vols. Transferred to Co B 48th OH Vols. Discharged 13 Apr 1866 at Columbus, OH at expiration of term of service. Disability: weakness of the spine, contracted Feb 1864. Born OH. Age 47. Residence subsequent to discharge: Brule Co Dakota. Occupation: clerk. Widower. P O Address of nearest relative: Frank G. BEVANS of Mansfield OH. Date of admission: 9 Sep 1880. Date of Death: April 1, 1882, caused by paralysis.
