BROWN, William* 22 Aug 1862

Private William Brown was age 40 when he entered service. He was killed in the battle of Arkansas Post, Arkansas. The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at Arkansas Post, Arkansas.

Minor children: John S., Mary E., Edmond, William D, Elizabeth A. born 11 Jun 1862. Minor child Elizabeth Anna died 6 Jan 1867. Marriage of Mr. William BROWN and Miss Elizabeth LYONS on 9 Feb 1858 in Cuyahoga Co OH, another page says 10 Feb. In Oct 1867 Elizabeth BROWN, widow of William, was a resident of Cleveland, Cuyahoga Co OH.

In 1863 when she applied, Elizabeth was 37 yrs old; So she was born about 1826. In November 1863 her post office address was West Salem, OH. John S. was age 13 in the fall of 1862, so he was born in about 1849. This means that the soldier was previously married. "Her husband left no children by a former marriage." Mary E. was 7 yrs old on 10 Aug 1862; so she was born about 1856. So she was also the child of the first wife. Edmund was age 4 on 16 Mar 1863; so he was born about 1859. William D. was age 2 on 14 May 1862; so he was born about 1860. Elizabeth Anne was 9 months old on 14 Mar 1863; so she was born about 1862.

William enrolled in the regiment at Ashland.
