

## Company F, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

BURKHOLDER, Leonard 22 Aug 1862

Private Burkholder was age 21 when he entered service. [No comments given.] I don't see him in the 48th or the 114th rosters. And there is no pension index card for him. [Note: He is listed at [Soldiers and Sailors database.](#)]

1850 Census, Wayne Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 169, Family 169: Henry BURKHOLDER, age 45 PA, farmer; Ann M., age 45 PA; William, age 17 PA; Elizabeth, age 16 PA; Catherine, age 14 PA; Henry, age 12 PA; Ann R., age 9 PA; Leonard, age 6 PA; Elias, age 5 PA; George, age 3 PA.

1860 Census, Montgomery Twp, Ashland County, OH, page 116: Henry BURKHOLDER, age 55 PA, farm reeper or keeper; Ann M, age 56 PA; Elizabeth, age 24 PA; Ann M, age 19 OH; Leonard, age 18 PA, farm laborer; Elias, age 17 PA, farm laborer; George, age 12 OH.

1870 Census, Brown Twp, Paulding County, OH, page 464: Lenard BURKHOLDER, age 29 OH, farm laborer is living with the George and Cornelia CLANIUS family.

Paulding County Probate Court record: Leonard E. BURKHOLDER married Mary Ellen HIMEBAUGH 26 Mar 1871 in Paulding County, OH.

1880 Census, Noble Twp, Wabash County, IN, page 368: Leonard BURKHOLDER, age 39 PA, farmer, parents born PA; Mary E, wife, age 30 OH, parents born PA; William, son, age 12 OH, farm laborer; Amanda, daughter, age 7 OH; Earnest, son, age 6 OH; Mary, daughter, age 4 OH; Charles, son, age 1 OH.

1900 Census, Series T623 Roll: 410, Noble Twp, Wabash Co IN, page 125: Leo BURKHOLDER, age 57 PA, born June 1842, married 29 yrs, teamster, parents born PA; Mary E, wife, age 51 OH, born May 1849, married 29 yrs, 8 children/8 still living, father born OH, mother born PA; Chas. M., son, age 22 OH, born Feb 1878, single, day laborer in furniture factory; Alta M, daughter, age 18 IN, born Mar 1882 single, housekeeper; Maud M, daughter, age 15 KS, born Aug 1884; Elsa E, son, age 13 KS, born Apr 1887; Elmer T, son, age 8 IN, born July 1891. [Maud M's obit in Indiana lists parents as Leonard BURKHOLDER and Mary Ellen HIEMBOUGH.]

1910 Census, Noble Twp, Wabash County, IN, page 128: Lenard BURKHOLDER, age 68 PA, first marriage, married 38 yrs, parents born PA, general farmer; Mary E, wife, age 60 OH, first marriage married 38 yrs, 8 children/8 still living, father born OH, mother born PA. [Note: No notation in Column 30 for military for Leonard.]

1920 Census, King St, Wabash, Noble Twp, Wabash County, IN, page 121: Head of household is Mary E, age 70 OH, married, no occupation, father born OH, mother born PA; Lenard E., husband, age 78 PA married, parents born PA, no occupation. [Recently I read that if a spouse died recently, then they will be listed this way in the census. Not sure in this case.]

Brother Elias' death record in Ohio: File # 23366, Elias P BURKHOLDER died 24 Apr 1926 at SS Home [Soldiers and Sailors Home], Perkins Twp, Erie Co OH. Widowed. Painter. Born 16 Mar 1841 PA. Parents Henry BURKHOLDER and Annie SEABORN, born PA. Burial at Old Soldiers and Sailors Home. [1870 Elias was in Toledo, Tama Co IA.] [Elias P was a Private in Co H, 132nd Ohio Inf. for 100 days including Washington DC. The 132nd was from Paulding, Montgomery, and Logan Counties.]

Sister Catherine's death record in Ohio: File # 34294, Mrs. Catherine CASKEY of North Grant St, died 24 May 1928 at Wooster, Wayne Co OH. Widow. Husband George CASKEY. Parents Henry BURKHOLDER and Anna SEABORN, born PA. Burial Wooster Cemetery. Informant Mrs. Jacob GAUL of Wooster OH.
