Private Clinger was age 35 when he entered service. He was killed or drowned 3 May 1864 in action near Snaggy Point on the Red River, Louisiana. No burial information in the Roll of Honor.

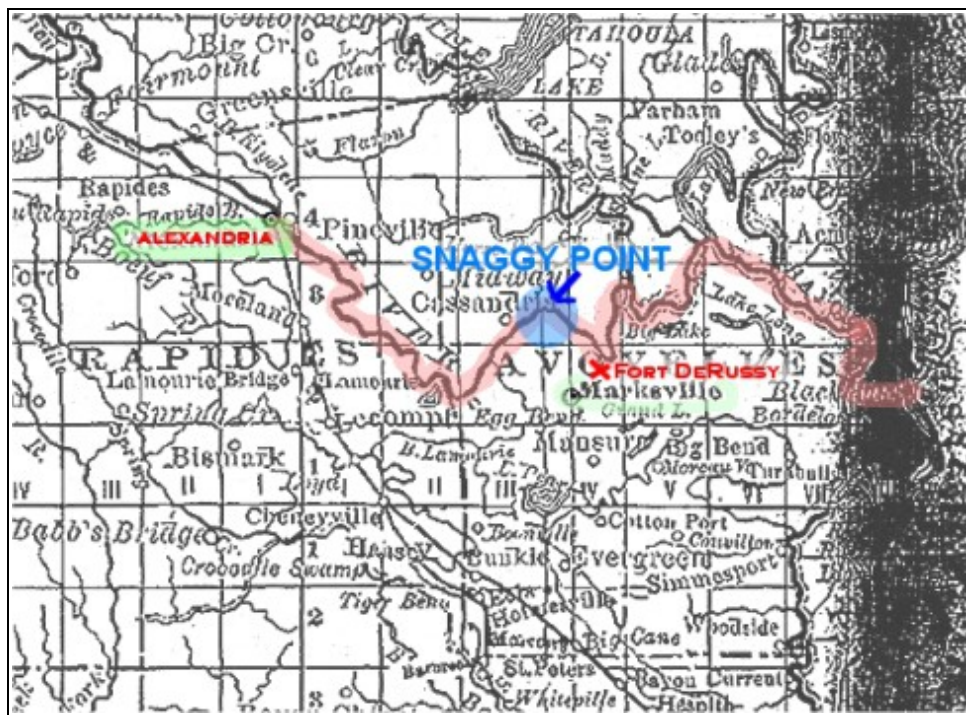

Pension Index 1: Andrew KLINGER, Co F 120th OH Inf. Widow Rebecca KLINGER applied 28 Dec 1864, Application 77340, Certificate 90345. Pension Index 2: Andrew CLINGER, F 120th OH Inf. A pension for a minor was applied for in Ohio 17 Sep 1890. The guardian was John D. McIntire. Application 478063, filed in OH. No certificate was recorded for the minor.

Holmes County Probate Court record: Andrew KLINGER married Rebecca REED 11 Sep 1849 in Holmes County OH.

1850 Census, Ripley Twp, Holmes County OH, Dwelling 850, Family 870: Andrew CLINER [sic], age 21 OH, laborer; Rebeca, age 38 PA; James, age 2 months OH. They are living with June [Jane] GARRETT and [her?] six children.

1860 Census, Rowsburg, Perry Twp, Ashland County, OH, page 232: Andrew CLINGER, age ?32 PA, laborer; Rebecca, age 36 MD; James W, age 10 OH; Sarah J, age 8 OH; Margaret E, age 4 OH; Mary A, age 1 OH.

1870 Census, Series: M593 Roll: 1169, Perry Twp, Ashland Co Oh, page 790: Rebecca CLINGER, age 55 PA; James, age 18 OH, day laborer; Mary A, age 10 OH.

1880 Census, Series: T9 Roll: 991, Rowsburg village, Ashland Co OH, page 198: Rebecca KLINGER, widow, age 62 MD, parents born PA; James, son, age 30 OH, single, laborer, father born MD, mother born OH; Mary, daughter, single, age 20 OH, servant, father born MD, mother born OH; Sarah J KLINGER, daughter, single, age 25 OH, milliner, father born MD, mother born OH.

Ohio, Deaths and Burials, 1854-1997: Rebecca CLINGER died 2 Nov 1882 at Ashland, Ashland Co OH. Age 68. Born <1814>.

Not found in 1890 Veterans Schedule.

Son's death record: Ohio, Deaths, 1908-1953: James CLINGER died 10 Jan 1920 at Perry, Ashland Co OH, age 70. Single. Laborer on farm. Born 26 Jul 1849, Wayne Co OH. Burial: Rowsburg Cemetery. Father Andrew CLINGER, born PA. Mother Rebecca REED, born Maryland. Informant: Hibbert S. REED, Polk OH.

Daughter's death record: Ohio, Deaths, 1908-1953: Mary A. REED died 12 Feb 1925 at Perry Twp, Ashland Co OH. Age 65. Married. Born 26 May 1859, Wayne Co OH. Burial at [Rowsburg](#). Father Andy CLINGER born PA. Mother Rebecca REED born Wayne Co OH. Spouse, O. W. REED. Informant: Mrs. J. MCGREGOR of Mansfield, OH.

Pension at fold3.com:

Andrew enrolled in the service at Rowsburg.

"Andrew Clinger was killed or drowned May 3, 1864 while on Steamer City Belle in an attack by the rebels."

Adjutant General's Office: " 'Taken Prisoner on Steamer City Belle May 3rd, 1864.' On Reg Return for May '64 reported 'Missing in action May 3rd 1864.' Dropped from Subsequent Returns.'

Andrew KLINGER and Rebecca REED were married 11 Sep 1849 at Holmes Co by T. J. Shrive, J.P.

James W. was born 26 July 1850.

Sarah J. was born 12 Dec 1852.

Mary A. was born 26 May 1859.

Jane GARRETT and Margaret BAKER, residents of Holmes Co OH, "were present when James W. Klinger and Sarah J Klinger children of Rebecca Klinger and Andrew Klinger were born." They said that James was born 26 June rather than July.

Mrs. Margaret JOB resident of Wayne Co OH "was the only woman present or immediately after at the birth of Mary A Klinger daughter of Rebecca Klinger and Andrew Klinger."

Papers say that Andrew had been previously married but had no children surviving him with that wife under the age of 16. Widow Rebecca KLINGER died 1882.
