CRUMRINE, David* 28 Aug 1862

Corporal Crumrine was age 40 when he entered service. He died 9 Apr 1863 at Milliken's Bend, Louisiana. The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi.

Death: 9 Apr 1863 at Milliken's Bend, LA, on the hospital steamer "D A January."

Cemetery: Vicksburg National Cemetery, MS [not listed] May be buried there as an unknown.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: David CREWRINE [incorrect, Corporal, Co F 120th OH Inf, died 9 Apr 1863 on the hospital steamer "D A January." Cause: mania.

Pension Index: David CRUMRINE, F 120th OH Inf. Widow Sarah Crumvine[sic] applied for pension in 1863 July 7, Application 26861, Certificate 49673, but no state was given. Also listed in Civil War Widows as Sarah Henny CRUMRINE widow of David, Co F 120th OH.

Wayne County Probate Court record: David CRUMRINE married Sarah HENRY on 23 Feb 1860 in Wayne Co OH.

[Note: Wayne County Probate Court record: Sarah CRUMRINE married J.P. MORR on 10 Mar 1867 in Wayne Co OH.]

Ohio, Deaths and Burials, 1854-1997: There was a Sarah MORR, born 1823, who died 3 May 1894 at Ashland, Ashland Co OH.

Philip MORR died 1890 in Wayne Co.....was he her second husband?

Pension record at fold3.com:

"Late Surgeon testifies that soldier, David Crumrine, contracted chronic diarrhea in Dec. 1862 while in the line of duty and continued sick until he died April 9, 1863, in Hospl at Millikens Bend La. of said disease."

Married Sarah 23 Feb 1860 at Wayne Co OH, by G. HARN? .

No children.

October 1863, Sarah Crumrine's address was LaFayette, Ashland Co OH.
