Pension Index: John M. DORLAND, F 120th, B 48th, and E 114th OH Inf. Invalid filed 1879 Aug 30, Application 306482, Certificate 203617, but no state was given. Pension Card: John died 22 Sep 1913 at Loudonville, OH.

Ohio Obituary Index says that John died in Ranklin, Illinois, on 22 Sep 1913. Born 1847. Nickname "Jack." Article is in Ashland Times 1 Oct 1913. Jack worked in the printing business "in most towns of Nothrn, Indiana." He was proof reader on the Danville News when he died.

1860 Census, Rowsburg, Perry Twp, Ashland County, OH, page 232: Garret DORLAND, age 56 PA, farmer; Cecelia, age 49 PA; George, age 24 OH; Clementine CORRELL, age 21 PA; John M DORLAND, age 11 PA. [Note: Elizabeth S DORLAND wife of Garritt died 1859 age 57...is buried at Rowsburg Cemetery, Ashland Co OH. Garret and Cecelia are buried at Burbank Cemetery Wayne Co OH.]

1900 Census, Sidell Twp, Sidell village, Vermilion, IL, house 9, line 39. : John M. DORLAND. age 53 OH, widowed, boarder, day laborer. Born Nov 1847, parents born OH. Living with the Albert B. and Minnie SMITH family. **Albert Smith is editor of a newspaper.**
