DORLAND, Charles H.\* 25 Aug 1862

Sergeant Charles Dorland was age 20 when he entered service. He died 29 Jan.1863 at St. Louis, Missouri. The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at St. Louis, Missouri in Jefferson Barracks Cemetery.

Cemetery: Jefferson Barracks [not listed] or Rowsburg Cemetery, CR 1302, Rowsburg, Perry Twp, Ashland County OH. There is a stone at Rowsburg.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: D. H. DORLAND, Private, Co F 120th OH Inf, died 29 Jan at New House of Refuge General Hospital St. Louis, MO. Cause: acute dysentery.

Have not found in Burial Registers, Military Posts and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960.

Charles' mother, Mary A. Dorland, applied for a pension 31 Mar 1890, Application 418298, no Certificate, filed in OH.

[female], age 15 OH; Wnzebeth? [Mary E], age 13 OH; Frances [female], age 11 OH; Henry, age 9 OH; William, age 3 OH. [Note: Holmes County Probate Court record: David DORLAND married Mary HEBRON on 22 Sep 1836 in Holmes Co OH.]
