DOW, William* 22 Aug 1862

Private Dow was age 18 when he entered service. He died 28 Jan 1863 at Young's Point, Louisiana. The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi.

Cemetery: Vicksburg, MS [Not listed.] Probably buried as an unknown.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Wm DOW, Private, Co F 120th OH Inf, died 28 Jan 1863 on a floating hospital before Vicksburg. Cause: typhoid fever.

Have not found in Burial Registers, Military Posts and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960.

Not on Pension Index.

Not positive that this is the right William Dow.

DOW, age 50 CT, farmer, Mary , age 49 PA; Mary, age 15 or 18 OH; Lorenza [male], age 8 OH; Martha J, age 10 OH; Willim, age 4 OH; Mary FOLTZ, age 50 or 30 OH. [Wayne County Probate Court record: Jeremiah K DOW married Mary REED on 15 Aug 1839 in Wayne Co OH. His first wife was Laura HAZEN.]

Brother's death record in Ohio: File # 68732, Phletus DOW died 4 Nov 1917 at Perrysville, Ashland Co OH. Married. Retired farmer. Born 3 Oct 1828 at Connecticut. Parents Jermane DOW and Laura HAZEN, born CT. Burial Green Lawn. Informant Chas DOW of Perrysville, OH. [Fletus was also a Civil War veteran, Pvt 15th Independent Battery OVLI.]

Brother's death record in OH: Lorenzo DOW died 4 Jun 1911 at Washington Twp, Holmes Co OH. Born 20 Mar 1843 at Washington Twp, Holmes Co OH. Widowed. Farmer. Burial Plum Run Cemetery. Father Jeremiah DOW born CT. Mother listed as unknown. [Note: Indiana Vol. Inf. and is actually buried at Loudonville Cemetery, Ashland Co OH.]
