FOREMAN, Samuel* 28 Aug 1862 Samuel FUHRMAN
Private Foreman was age 21 when he entered service. He died 14 Jan 1863 at Arkansas Post, Ark. The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at Arkansas Post, Arkansas.

Information at [Find a Grave](#). Red Haw Cemetery: Samuel FUHRMAN, son of M and E. Died in the Civil War 1863 age 21 y. Stone not found in 2009 but old record says that there was a stone. Parents are buried there. The Evangelical Messenger 3 June 1863, page 182 states that he was buried on the White River Island No 62 in Arkansas and that his body was not found after. Parents: Michael FURHMAN and Elizabeth were farming in Jackson Twp, Ashland Co OH in 1870....both born PA

Sons of Union Veterans: Born 14 May 1841. Red Haw Cemetery, CR 175, Red Haw, Perry Twp, Ashland County, OH.

Ashland County Cemeteries - Red Haw Cemetery: Samuel FUHRMAN, son of M and E. Died in the Civil War 1863 age 21 y [Michael and Elizabeth are buried there too. .]
