KEPNER, Amos B.* 23 Feb 1864

Private Kepner was age 18 when he entered service. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River, Louisiana; he died 30 Sept 1864 in Rebel Prison at Tyler, Texas. [Camp Ford]

The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at Alexandria, Louisiana in section 18 grave 50.

Soldier's parents, Amos [10 Dec 1873] and Rebecca [11 Aug 1874] are buried at Mennonite Cemetery, Alto, Kent Co, MI. [Christian Family Companion Obit.
