LONDERWITCH, William* 20 Apr 1864 William LAUTERMILCH

Private Londerwitch was age 16 when he entered service. He died 15 Aug 1864 at Morganzia, Louisiana. The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at Port Hudson, Louisiana.

Loutermile, Wm, d. 08/15/1864, PVT, Plot: 1103 This same soldier is listed at US Department of Veterans Affairs as Wm LOUTERMILE, Pvt, US Army, death 15 Aug 1864 at Port Hudson National Cemetery. But the stone says USCT, which stands for United States Colored Troops. But the Ohio Roster doesn't mention any transfer.

At Civil War Soldiers and Sailors System, name is spelled LOUDERMILCH and LOUTERMILCH.

1860 Census, Ganges, Bloominggrove Twp, Richland Co OH, Dwelling 884, Family 912: Louisa LOUTERMILCH, age 31 Germany, seamstress; William, age 12 Germany; Letta, age 8 OH; Ada, age 6 OH; Gustave, age 3 OH; Louisa [f] age 8 months OH....Was actually be Louis Conrad [m], born 9 Nov 1859.

Ohio Marriages: mother Louisa LAUTERMILCH married Charles SCHLOEZER on 14 Nov 1861 at Richland Co OH.

Mother Louisa Schloezer died 1898, buried at Shelby-Oakland Cemetery, Richland Co OH. She had a son Julius SCHLOEZER 1862-1866 who would have been half brother to the soldier William.
