LUTZ Emanuel* 30 Aug 1862 Alternate name LUTS
Private Lutz was age 21 when he entered service. He died 17 Feb 1863 at Young's Point, Louisiana.
The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi, section C grave 127.
