MENTER, George H.* 22 Aug 1862

Private Menter was age 23 when he entered service. He died 4 July 1863 at Jefferson Barracks, Missouri. The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at St Louis, Missouri, in Jefferson Barracks Cemetery in section 2, grave 220.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: George H. MENTER, Private, Co F 120th OH Inf, died 4 July 1863 at General Hospital Jefferson Barracks, MO. Cause: chronic diarrhoea.

Have not found in Burial Registers, Military Posts and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960.

Pension Index: George H. Menter, Co F 120th OH Inf. George's mother, Delilah Menter, applied for a pension 2 May 1864, Application 50827, Certificate 33955.

1850 Census, Bedford, Cuyahoga Co OH, Dwelling 1427, Family 1553: Hiram MINTER, age 52 MA, no occupation listed; Delia, age 35 England; James, age 16 NY; Samuel, age 15 NY; George, age 12 OH; Charlotte, age 9 OH; Mary L, age 7 OH; Henrietta, age 3 OH.

Father Hiram died in 1851/52

1860 Mary Mentor is living with Butler family in Cuyahoga co OH. Age 16. But I don't know where George is.

sister: 1870 Census, Cleveland Ward 5, Cuyahoga Co OH, Dwelling 877, Family 978: Chas. FULLER, age 27 OH, railroad brakeman; Henrietta, age 23 OH; Laura MAELDER, age 54 England.

sister and mother: 1880 Census, Detroit, Wayne Co MI, Dwelling 38, Family 58: Henrietta D. FULLER, wife, age 33 OH, married, dress maker, father born MA, mother born England; Lizzie WILLIAMS, daughter, single, age 14 England, parents born England; Deliah MENTER, wife, age 64 England, widow, house keeper, parents born England. [Mother, Delilah, died 1882.]

Pension at fold3.com:

George enrolled 22 Aug 1862, but did he leave and come back 14 Oct 1863?

Delilah MENTER mother of George H. MENTER, post office address Bedford, Cuyahoga Co OH. She was age 47 as of 29 Feb 1864. George died of chronic diarrhoea on 4 July 1863 at Jefferson Barracks, MO. Delilah had been married to Hiram MENTER on 14 Oct 1839. Hiram died 13 Sept 1851/52 at Bedford OH. So she was dependent on her son for help. George "for at least two years before entering the service of the United States worked as 'shoemaker' regularly earning thirty-five dollars per month out of which he gave his mother at least twenty-five (25) dollars per month...used by her to pay house rent, buy provisions or clothes and to obtain whatever she might need for her comfort and support. Said Geo H Menter at all times made it his home with his Mother, and treated the family in every respect as though it had been his own. Since said Geo H Menter entered the service he has sent his Mother it twp (2) dollars for the reason that he was not paid till April 2 months before his death." Witnessed by H D DICKEY and Thomas Matheany. George's mother died in 1882 [?March]
