SHRINER, George 10 Oct 1862

Private Shriner was age 22 when he entered service. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point, on the Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 7 July 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio.

1860 Census, Milton Twp, Ashland Co OH, William SHIVER, age 62 PA, farmer; Susanna, age 60 PA; Wm, age 32 PA, wagon maker; Mary, age 24 PA; Peter, age 21 PA, farm laborer; George, age 20 PA, farm laborer; Benjamin CORTS, age 4 OH.

1870 Census, Harrison Twp, Elkhart IN, Dwelling 161, Family 162: George SHRINER, age 28 PA, works on farm; he is living with the Jacob and Barbara YODER family.

1900 Census, German Twp, Marshall Co IN, Dwelling 27, Family 27: George SCHRINER, age 62 PA, born Jan 1839, married 21 yrs, parents born PA, farmer; Julia A, wife, age 65 OH, born Feb 1841, married 21 yrs, 8 children, 7 still living, father born NJ, mother born PA.

1910 Census, German Twp, Marshall Co IN, Dwelling 206, Family 209: George SCHRINER, age 74 PA, first marriage, married 30 yrs PA, parents born PA, has own income, marked UA for military service; Julia A, wife, age 76 OH, second marriage, married 30 yrs, 6 children/2 still living, father born VA, mother born PA.

Julie Ann BLUE SHRINER was married 4 times before marrying George. She died 8 Dec 1915. Buried at Riverside Church, Bremen, Marshall Co IN. [WorldConnect]

1920 Census, Baltimore st, 2nd ward, Bremen, German Twp, Marshall Co IN, Dwelling 117, Family 119: George SHRINNER, age 80 PA, widowed, parents born PA, no occupation. '

"Old Civil War Veteran Dies at Advanced Age

George Schriner, aged 86 years and 23 days, died Monday at the residence of Mr. And Mrs. Randle Sellers [note: Mrs. Sellers was Julia's daughter], southwest of Bremen, of the infirmities of age. He was for many years a resident of the Riverside vicinity, and served as a soldier in the war of the Rebellion. He was an uncle of David Schriner of Bremen, and a relative of Mrs. Sellers. He was born in Pennsylvania Nov. 5, 1835.

Funeral services were held today in Grace United Brethren church in Bremen by Rev. Borert. Interment was in the Bremen cemetery."
