SLOAN, Thomas H.\* 15 Aug 1862 Thomas Hunter SLOAN

Private Sloan was age 23 when he entered service. He died 6 Feb 1863 at Young's Point, Louisiana. The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi.
