

## Company F, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

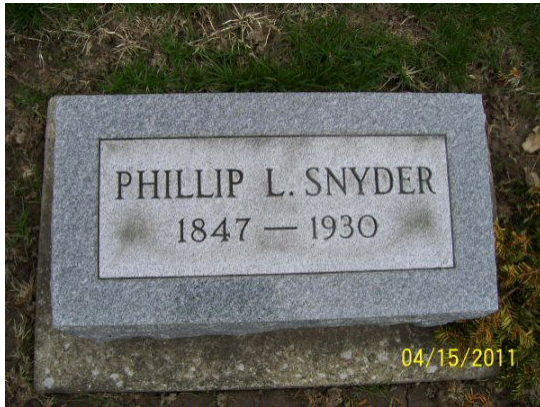

SNYDER, Philip 4 Feb 1864

Private Philip Snyder was age 19 when he entered service.

He was transferred to Co. E 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864.

Transferred to Co B, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 9 May 1866.

Father: Benjamin SNYDER

Mother: Mary BIDDINGER

Birth: 7 Apr 1847, Greenwich, Huron Co OH.

Marriage: Alice LYON, 3 Jul 1873, Richland Co OH

Death: 28 May 1930 in the Old Soldiers and Sailors Home Hospital in Perkins Twp, Erie Co OH

Cemetery: Greenwich Greenlawn Cemetery, Greenwich, Huron Co OH

Relationship: Brother of Marion SNYDER, Co F 120th OVI

Pension Card: Phillip SNYDER, Co F 120th OH Inf, Co B 48th OH Inf, Co E 114th OH Inf. Invalid applied 15 Mar 1888, Application 645013, Certificate 772113, filed in OH. Phillip died 28 May 1930 at State Soldiers Home, OH.

1850 Census, Montgomery Twp, Ashland Co OH, Dwelling 494, Family 506: Benjamin SNYDER, age 34 PA, millwright; May, age 22 OH; Philip, age 3 OH; Marion [female] age 1yr6mths OH. [Ohio, County Marriages: Benjamin SNYDER married Mary BIDDINGER, 19 Oct 1845, Richland Co OH.]

1860 Census, Series M653 Roll 930, Troy Twp, Ashland Co OH, page 23: Benjamin SNIDER, age 46 PA, millwright; Mary, age 32 OH; Phillip, age 13 OH; Marion, age 11 OH [see soldier Marion above]; Sarah A, age 9 OH; Mary, age 8 OH; Elizabeth E, age 7 OH; Geo W. age 5 OH.

1870 Census, Series M593 Roll 1225, New London Twp, Huron Co OH, page 377: Phillip SNYDER, age 23 OH, works in cheese factory. He is listed with a group of people who work in the cheese factory.

Richland Co Probate Court record: Philip SNYDER married Alice LYON on 3 Jul 1873 in Richland Co OH.

1880 Census, Series T9, Roll 381, Ellsworth town, Ellsworth, KS, page 489: P SNEIDER, age 33 OH, dairyman, father born PA, mother born OH; Alice, wife, age 26 OH, father born OH, mother born NY; Abbert, son, age 6 OH; Lelan, son, age 3 OH; W. B. ROBINSON, other, age 30 IN, house carpenter, parents born VA.

Did not find in 1890 Veterans Schedule.

1900 Census, Series T623 Roll 1288, Greenwich, Huron Co OH, page 69: Phillip SNYDER, age 53 OH, born Mar 1847, married 26 yrs, day laborer, father born PA, mother born OH; Alice, wife, age 46 OH, born Dec 1853, 5 children/4 still living, , father born OH, mother born NY; Albert M, son, age 25 OH, single, born Oct 1874, hardware clerk; Hellen G, daughter, age 18 OH, single, born Dec 1881; Warren, son, age 15 OH, born Aug 1884.

1910 Census, Series T624 Roll 1200, Greenwich village, Huron Co OH, page 249: Philip SNYDER age 63 OH, first marriage, married 38 yrs, grocery clerk, father born PA, mother born OH; Alice, wife, age 51? OH, first marriage, married 38 yrs, 5 children/4 still living, father born OH, mother born VT. [Column 30 was not marked for military service.]

Death record in Ohio: File # 29466, Philip SYDER, who served in the Army, died 28 May 1930 in the Old Soldiers and Sailors Home Hospital in Perkins Twp, Erie Co OH. Widower. Born 7 Apr 1847 at Greenwich, Huron Co OH. His father was Benjamin SNYDER, born PA. Mother was Mary, born OH. Burial Greenwich OH.

Wife's Death record in Ohio: File # 5898, Alice L SNYDER, died 16 Jan 1929 at Greenwich, Huron Co OH. Married. Husband Philip SNYDER. Born 15 Dec 1853 at Greenwich OH. Father Octavus LYON, born Mace. OH. Mother Helen BRIGGS, born NY. Burial Greenwich OH. Informant P. H. SNYDER, of Greenwich OH.
