VANOMAN, Marion* 7 Oct 1862 Isaac, VAN ARNAM VANORNAM VANORMAN
Private Vanoman was age 18 when he entered service. He died 5 Mar 1863 in hospital at Young's point, Louisiana.
The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi.
