WERTMAN, George W.* 19 Aug 1862

Private Wertman was age 19 when he entered service. He died 9 May 1863 in a hospital at Milliken's Bend, Louisiana.

The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi in section D, grave 192.

Cemetery: Vicksburg National Cemetery. Wertman, J.W., d. 09 May 1863, Plot: E 1644, Civil War, Co I 120th OH [Note: There is no WERTMAN in Co I, so I think this is George. See Burial Registers record below.]

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: G. W. WERTMAN, Private, Co F 120th OH Inf, died 9 May 1863 at Van Buren General Hospital Millikens bend, LA. Cause: chronic diarrhoea.

Burial Registers, Military Posts and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960: G. W. WERTMAN, Private Co F [I crossed out], 120th OH Inf. Died 9 May 1863. Vicksburg Section E 192

National Cemetery Interment Control Forms, 1928-1962: G. W. WESTMAN (WERTMA, E. W.), Co I 120 OH.

Died 9 May 1863. Vicksburg National Cemetery, section E grave 1644. For original burial see N. Cramer. [Note: N. CRAMER, Co A 16th IN, died 8 May 1863 and is buried at Vicksburg, Se E grave 1620. Was originally buried at graveyard at Marshal plantation on west bank of Mississippi river in Madison Parish, LA.]
