

## Company G, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

BOWMAN, Jacob\* 29 Sep 1862

Jacob, age 18, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 261 as a private. He died 7 Mar 1863 at Young's Point, LA. The Roll of Honor in the back of the Roster book lists Jacob Bowman as being buried at Vicksburg, Miss.

Cemetery: Vicksburg, MS [Not listed] May be buried there as an unknown.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Jacob BOWMAN, Co G 120th OH Inf. Died 7 Mar 1863 at Regimental Hospital. Cause: typho mal fever.

Not found in Burial Registers, Military Posts and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960.

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed Jacob Bowman's residence as Chippewa.

Not on 1890 Veterans Schedule.
