CLOUSE, George W.* 18 Oct 1862

George, age 34, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 261 as a private.

George **died** 19 Feb 1863 at Young's Point Louisiana. The Roll of Honor in the back of the Roster book lists George W. Clouse as being buried at Vicksburg, Miss.

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed Geo. McCLOUSE's residence as Bucyrus. [Crawford county]

I can't find this soldier in the census.

One in Monroe Twp, Licking Co OH, and the one in Tennessee were still living in 1870.

George Clouse, age 34 <1826> OH, Jackson Coshocton Co OH, Family 244 in the 1860 Census with the DICKY family. Still living in 1870

One in Michigan in 1860 born in Canada still living in 1870
