

Company G, 120th Ohio Volunteer Infantry

DETRICK, Jacob 13 Aug 1862 Dietrich

Jacob, age 45, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 261 as a private.

He transferred to Co K 114th OVI 27 Nov 1864. Mustered out 5 June 1865 at New Orleans, LA, by order of War Dept.

Jacob enlisted at Chippewa Township. His pension papers say that he was ill and in the Marine USA General Hospital from 24 Jan 1865 until he mustered out.

Jacob Detrick married Catherine Amanda Garrison in the early 1840s. Born to them were *John G.* (of Akron OH) and *George*, both also of this Company G, Henry J. and Sara Thompson (of Red Oak, Iowa). They were born in PA. The family is in the 1850 census in Clearfield Co PA (before Sara's birth.) In 1859 Jacob moved to the Westfield area of Medina County OH. It was called Le Roy then. Catherine Amanda died in 1860. [Find a Grave](#): Catherine A DETRICK, wife of Jacob, is buried at Friendsville Cemetery, Westfield Center, Medina Co OH. She was age 35 y 3 m 20dys. She died 10 Jan 1860. He married Polly Tinsler on 3 June 1860.

From his pension record: Jacob was wounded during the war in his leg. Jacob died 22 Sep 1895 and is buried in Friendsville Cemetery. [Medina County: Friendsville is west of Westfield Center, straight west through Westfield Center on the road going to Lodi. His first wife is buried there.]

1850 Census, Pike Twp, Clearfield Co PA, Dwelling 23, Family 23: Jacob DETRICK, age 31 PA, blacksmith; Catherine A, age 27 PA; John, age 5 PA; George, age 3 PA; Henry J, age 2 months PA.

Catherine died 1860 in LeRoy, Madison Co, OH. [Hillend Tree at Ancestry.com]

Ohio Marriages: Jacob DETRICK married Polly TINSLUR on 3 June 1860 in Wayne Co OH.

[Note: Daughter's Death Record: File # 40582, Margaret HOOK, of 500 High St, died 1 July 1922 at Barberton, Summit Co OH. Widow. Born 11 Aug 1860 at Seville, OH. Parents Jacob DEITRICH and Polly CINCOX, born PA. Burial Easton OH. Informant Mrs. Myrtle HARRIS of 500 High St. Easton Cemetery is on route 585 in Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH] [Note: the 1900 census has Margaret's birth as July 1861.]

1860 Census, West Field Twp, Medina County OH, page 56, census taken 23 June 1860: Jacob DETRICK, age 40 PA, blacksmith; John, age 15 PA; Geo, age 14 PA[see soldier George above]; Sarah, age 4 PA; Jas, age 2 PA, Mary, age 23 OH.

It could be that Mary [Polly] was listed with her new husband and with her parents in 1860.

1860 Census Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH page 386

This household was visited on 26 June 1860. So this may or may not be the Polly that Jacob married.

James Tinsler age 62, a farmer born in New York

Nancy, age 64, born in PA

Polly, age 23, born in OH

[Note: Polly is also listed with James and Nancy in 1850.]

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed Jacob Detrick's residence as Chippewa.

1870 Census, Chippewa, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 184, Family 192: Jacob DETRICK, age 58, PA, blacksmith; Mary, age 35 OH; Margaret, age 8 OH; Nancy J, age 4 OH; Valandigham, age 2 OH; Elizabeth, age 1 OH.

1880 Census, Guilford Twp, Seville, Medina Co, OH, Dwelling 397, Family 424: Jacob DETRICK, age 60 PA, blacksmith, parents born PA; Mary, age 35 OH, father born NY, mother born Ireland; Clement L, age 11 OH, Emma E, age 10 OH; Mary R, age 8 OH; William H, age 7 OH; Josephine, age 3 OH. [Notes: His age is off by a couple of years and so is Polly's!!way off!! Polly was a common nickname for Mary. Jacob was in business in Medina County until he died in 1895.]

1890 Veterans Schedules: page 2 Guilford Twp, Medina, OH, line 21, Jacob DEITRICK, Private, Co G 120th OH Inf, disabilities: wounded left arm, asthma, eyes?. Post Office Seville, Medina Co OH.

In the History of Medina County 1948 (by the Medina County Historical Society) page 92: "There was a smithy at the corner east of Seville where Jacob Detrick plied his trade for more than one generation."

Will of Jacob Detrick from record book of Medina county Ohio recorded on microfilm:

Be it remembered: That on the 10th day of October A.D. 1895 there was presented in open Court a paper writing purporting to be the Last Will and Testament of Jacob Detrick late of this county, deceased, which said instrument is as follows:

In the name of the Benevolent Father of all

I, Jacob Detrick being of sound mind and memory, do make this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me at any time made.

It is my will in case of my death that my beloved wife Mary Detrick have & hold all of my property both personal and Real during her natural life.

After the death of Mary Detrick my beloved wife what remains of my property to be divided equally among Emma Stone, Josahine [*sic*] Detrick and Bell Stull her Bell Stall's share to be held in trust for Jacob Reed her son, to be given to him when he is of age.

Application to Probate Will:

In the matter of the Will of Jacob Detrick Deceased.

To the Honorable, the Judge of said Court:

And now comes Mrs. Jennie Cook and produces for admission to Probate in said Court, the Last Will and Testament of Jacob Detrick, late a resident of the township of Guilford in said County, who died on or about the 22 day of September A. D. 1895.

Said Testator died leaving Polly Detrick his widow and the following named persons, all of his next of kin.

Afterward to wit: On the 10th day of October A.D. 1895 said Court made an order in said matter which is as follows:

In the matter of the last will and testatment of Jacob Detrick deceased:

This day there was presented in open court a paper writing purporting to be the last will and testament of Jacob Detrick late of this county deceased, and an application was filed asking to have the same admitted to probate as the last will and testament of the said decedent. It is therefore ordered that said will be filed and that notice issue to the widow of said decedent and all the next of kin who are residents of Ohio notifying them of the filing and of the time fixed for the hearing of said application which said time of hearing is hereby fixed for the 24th day of Oct 1895 at 10 o'clock A. M. to which time this matter is continued.

[webmaster note: There is more repetative legaleze here. On the 27th of October Polly was ordered to appear befor the court "to make her election whether she will take under the provision of the will of her late husband or be endowed of the lands of her said husband and take her distributive share of the personal estate." Mary did appear in person on 23 October 1895 and made her mark to certify that she was electing "to take" under the provisions of the will.]

In the Medina County Gazette Thursday 29 Oct.1896 appears this note in the section called Court House Calendar: Probate Court: "Estate of Jacob Detrick, Mary Detrick, widow, elects to take under will."

Jacob died 22 Sept 1895 and is buried in Friendsville Cemetery. [To get to Friendsville, go straight west through Westfield Center in Medina County on the road going to Lodi.]

Have not found Mary Polly DETRICK in 1900 census.

Daughter's Death Record: File #40072, Emma E STONE died 9 June 1916 at 541 Sumner St, Akron, Summit Co OH. Married. Born 9 May 1872 in OH. Father Jacob DETRICK, born PA. Mother unknown, born OH. Burial Glendale Cemetery. Informant Robert STONE, of 541 Sumner St.
