EATON, James 28 July 1862  
James, age 18, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 260 as Musician.  
He was appointed 1 Oct 1863. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River in Louisiana. He mustered out 7 July 1865 at Camp Chase OH by order of the War Department.

The Ohio Civil War Grave Registration site listed James Eaton of Company G 120th OVI as being buried in Wayne co OH. James Eaton is buried at Chestnut Hill Cemetery in Doylestown. Stone says he is son of F. and M. and he died 4 Feb 1868 at age 21 yrs. and ????. Buried there also are Friend and Mary J Eaton who are his parents. Friend died in 1853 at age 48, but there is a Mary Eaton listed in the 1860 census index book. His brother Jackson is also buried there, Co H 8th OH.

1850 Census, Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 225, Family 233: Friend EATON, age 47 Maine, farmer; Mary, age 42 PA; Nathan, age 17 OH; Amanda, age 15 OH; Sarah, age 13 OH; Abijah [mistake f], age 11 OH; Jackson, age 9 OH; Wm, age 7 OH; James P, age 4 OH; Lewis C, age 2 OH.

1860 census, Chippewa twp, Wayne Co OH page 378: Mary EATON, age 48 PA, weaver; Sarah, age 22 OH; Abijah, age 20 OH, farm hand; Jackson, age 18 OH, farm hand; William, age 16 OH [see William below]; James, age 14 OH, farm hand; Lewis, age 12 OH; Elisabeth C, age 8 OH.

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed James Eaton's residence as Chippewa.

Wayne County Grave Registration Cards book: James Eaton, address Wayne County, died 4 Feb 1868, born 6 April 1846, buried Chestnut Hill.

The 1860 census record and the tombstone seem to point to the fact that James was only 16 when he joined Company G.

Sister's Death Record in Ohio:: File #30318, Sarah E LEE died 1 May 1911 at Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH. Widow. Born 28 Jan 1838 at Cuyahoga Co. Parents Friend EATON and Mary LAW. Burial ?Krupps or Kufupps? Cemetery. Informant William
