

Company G, 120th Ohio Volunteer Infantry

FISHER, Erasmus D. 15 Aug 1862

Erasmus, age 18, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 260 as a Sergeant. There are no comments listed in the Roster. [Note: Erasmus Fisher is not on the list of prisoners at Camp Ford.]

1850 census, Chippewa twp, Wayne co OH

A. Fisher (34 PA) a cabinet maker, Lydia DANIELS (59 Mass.), Erasmus D (7 OH), Aurelia S. (5 OH), Cath [Catherine] MARSHALL (28 MD). [Catherine's maiden name was DAILY]

Father, Archibald FISHER, married Catharine DAILY 15 Oct 1851 in Summit Co OH. Information at Family Search.

1860 census, Doylestown, Chippewa Twp. Wayne Co OH page 360

Archibald Fisher (42 PA) a cabinet maker, all others born in OH, Catherine (33), Erasmus (16), Arelia (14), Emma J. (7), Ada A. (6), Ella S. (4), Viola M. (2), no name girl (2 months).

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed Erasmus Fisher's residence as Chippewa.

[Note: By 1870 there were two more children, Samuel born <1864> and Minnie, born <1867>. But Erasmus isn't listed.]

I am wondering if Erasmus died before the 1870 census....but if so, why is he not listed in a cemetery in Chippewa Twp? His father is buried at Chestnut Hill.

Brother, Samuel's Death Record in Ohio: Born 13 Aug 1864, shows his parents were Archibald FISHER and Catherine DAILY.] Catherine is also the mother of Viola, Sarah Ellen, and Emma. But Catherine would not be the mother of Erasmus.

????Some other possibles below.....but I have no idea about them.

1880 Census, Grant St, 2nd Ward Council Bluff, Pottawattamie, IA, Dwelling 65, Family 66: Erasmus FISHER, age 35 OH, tobacconist, father born OH, mother born CT; Rebecca, age 28 PA, parents born PA; Frank AUSTIN, age 10 IL, servant, parents born unknown.

1885 Iowa State Census, Council Bluffs, Kane, Pottawattamie, IA, page 19, Family 136: Erasmus D. F. FISHER, age 40; Rebecca J, age 30.

???????1910 Census, Series T624 Roll 1082, Central Islip State Hospital, Suffolk Co NY, page 153: Erasmus D. F. FISHER, patient, single, age 66, born OH, parents born US?, kitchen helper in the hospital. [Note: not marked for military service.....none marked on that page for military service.] [He was at Manhattan State Hospital, Islip, in 1900. Also listed as single.]
