

## Company G, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

FLICKINGER, Benjamin\* 22 Aug 1862

Benjamin, age 18, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 261 as a private. Benjamin died 15 Apr 1863 at Milliken's Bend, Louisiana. The Roll of Honor in the back of the Roster book lists Benjamin Flickinger as being buried at Vicksburg, Miss.

Cemetery: Vicksburg National Cemetery, MS [not listed] May be buried there as an unknown.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Benjamin FLICKENERS, Private, Co G 120th OH Inf, died 14 Apr 1863 at Van Buren General Hospital, Millikens Bend, LA. Cause: chronic diarrhoea.

Pension: Benjamin's parents filed for his pension. Co G 120th OH Inf.

Mother: Sarah Flickinger filed 8 Oct 1868: Application 166.297; Certificate 124.634

Father: Daniel Flickinger filed 29 July 1882: Application 295.231; Certificate 205.335

1850 Federal Census, Chippewa Twp., Wayne co. OH. Daniel Flickinger (46), a shoemaker, Sarah (42), Josiah (21) moulder, Jacob (19) potter, Susannah (17), Saul(hard to read) (15), Jno (John) (13), Wm (11), Sarah and Mary A. twins (9), Eliz (7), Benj (5), James H. (2). The parents were born in PA, the children all in OH.

[Note: This could be Benjamin's mother's maiden name: Stark County Probate records: Daniel Flickinger married Sally Whorley, 7 Aug 1827 in Stark co OH. Brother, William's death record verifies the mother's name as Susana WEARLY and father David FLICKINGER, both born PA. Brother James' Death Record says Daniel Flickinger but doesn't know Sarah's maiden name. Another brother, Daniel born 1835, lists father as Daniel FLICKINGER and mother as WERLEY born in MD. Ohio Marriages: Daniel FLICKINGER married Sally WHORLEY on 7 Aug 1827 at Stark Co OH. ]

[A moulder was a person who shaped sand into which molten metal was poured in a foundry. Definition found in "A to Zax" by Barbara Jean Evans]

1860 census Doylestown, Chippewa twp, Wayne Co OH page 361

Daniel Flickinger (55 PA) boot and shoemaker, Sarah (53 PA), all others born in OH, John (22 a potter), William (21 a potter), Mary (19), Sarah (19), Elizabeth (17), Benjamin (15), James H. (11).

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed Benjamin Flickinger's residence as Chippewa.

1870 Census, Doylestown, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 25, Family 35: Daniel FLICKINGER, age 65 PA, shoemaker; Sarah, age 62 PA; Elizabeth BECKWITH, age 27 OH; Charles BECKWITH, age 2 OH.

1880 Census, Doylestown, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 228, Family 237: Daniel FLICKINGER, age 75 PA, no occupation, parents born PA; Sarah, wife, age 74 PA, parents born PA; Sarah, daughter age 36 OH, single.

Ohio Obituary Index: Sarah FLICKINGER, wife of Daniel, died at age 74 at Doylestown OH on 10 April 1882.

Ohio Obituary Index: Daniel FLICKINGER died at Doylestown OH, 4 Oct 1889.

Not found on 1890 Veterans Schedule.
