

## Company G, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

HAMMAN, Daniel\* 22 Aug 1862 HOMMON [Civil War Soldiers and Sailors System]  
Daniel, age 20, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 261 as a private. Daniel died 30 Jan 1863 at Young's Point, Louisiana. The Roll of Honor in the back of the Roster book lists Daniel Hamman as being buried at Vicksburg, Miss.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Daniel HOWMAN, Private, Co G 120th OH Inf, died 31 Jan 1863 at Regimental Hospital. Cause: Rubeola [measles].

Not on Burial Registers, Military Posts and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960.

Not on U.S. National Cemetery Interment Control Forms, 1928-1962

Have not found in Pension Index.

1850 Census, Congress, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 259, Family 261: Elizabeth HUMMON, age 37 PA, Daniel, age 8 OH; Andrew, age 4 OH.

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed Daniel HAMMON's residence as Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH.

These are very difficult to read. This is Ancestry.com's interpretation:

1860 Census, Chippewa, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 395, Family 3\*\*: Barnhart BOS, age 42; Elisabeth BOS, age 47; Catherine BOS, age one; Daniel HOWSMAN, age 18; Andrew J HOMEN, age 14.

Daniel's brother? [1870 Census, Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 331, Family 342 Andrew HOWMAN, age 24 Ohio, farmer; Eliza, age 24 PA; Mary E, age 2 OH; Melington, age one OH.

Andrew HOWMAN, born 1845 , and Eliza Yocum Howman are buried in Congress Cemetery. [He died 1871](#). He also served in Civil War. Andrew J. HOMMAN, 5th OH Cav. Pension Index: Andrew HOMMAN, Co I 5th OH Cav, widow Eliza, filed 23 Nov 1888, application 384412, Certificate 348392, filed in OH. ]
