

Company G, 120th Ohio Volunteer Infantry

HARBAUGH, John 20 Aug 1862 John Henry HARBOUGH [There is also a John HARBAUGH in Company D of the 120th OVI, born about 1835, so he is older than this soldier.]

John, age 18, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 262 as a Corporal. He was appointed 12 Apr 1863. He was transferred to Co. K 3rd Regiment, Veteran Reserve Corps on 22 Apr 1864. He mustered out 16 Aug 1865 at Hartford, Connecticut by order of the War Department.

"List of Casualties...while on board the Steamer 'City Belle' near 'Snaggy Point' La, May 3d 1864...." Corpl. John HARBAUGH, missing, wounded in arm. [From the records of the Ohio Adjutant General, available at the Ohio Historical Society, Columbus, OH. Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

Note: John Harbaugh is listed by Camp Ford as being present the day the prisoners were released.. So he must have been on board the City Belle and captured.
