HART, Patrick 19 Feb 1864
 Patrick, age 30, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 262 as a private. He was transferred to Co. K 114th OVI 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co C, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 9 May 1866.
 Pension papers say Patrick enrolled at Columbus OH on 9 Feb 1864. He mustered out 9 May 1866 at Galveston, TX [pension record].

 Birth: ??Mar 1842 Tyrone, Ireland

 Patrick is buried in Section 14, Range 11, Plot B, Grave 13. In 1888 he purchased 5 burial plots in that section. It will cost \$110 to get all the information about who the others are that are buried there. [Wife: Catherine died 27 May 1914.]

??Civil War Draft Registrations Records, 1863-1865, June 1863: Patrick HART, in Columbus, age 30, white, laborer, married, born Ireland. Since his pension papers say that he joined infantry at Columbus, OH, this draft record could be the correct Patrick Hart.

[Pension Record: Webmaster sent for this one.] Patrick had florid complexion, grey eyes, black hair. Born Tyrone Ireland. Places lived since leaving the service: [New York City] 306 10th Ave, 455 W. 28th St, 450 West 28th St, 443 West 28th St, 447 West 28th St, 303 10th Ave. In April 1907 his address was 303 10th Ave, NY City. Patrick died at 435 West 25th St and it was described as a "tenement." Patrick was a foundry watchman.

1880 Census, 450 West 28th St, City of NY, NY Co, NY, Dwelling 59, Family 194: Patrick HART, age 44 Ireland, laborer; Catherine, wife, age 44 Ireland, parents born Ireland; Marie, daughter, age 22 Ireland [born 1858].....dressmaker.

Not found in 1890 Veterans Schedule.

1900 Census, 28th St., Manhattan, District 0217, New York, NY, Dwelling 66, Family 69: Patrick HART, born Mar 1842, age 58 Ireland, married 40 yrs, parents born Ireland, immigrated 1866, been in US 34 yrs, naturalized, laborer; Catherine, wife, born Dec 1841, age 59 Ireland, married 40 yrs, one child/one still living, parents born Ireland, immigrated 1866, been in US 34 yrs; Ellen CORRIGAN, sister, born Oct 1836, age 64 Ireland, single, parents born Ireland, immigrated 1866, in US 34 yrs, laundress.

?1910 Manhattan Ward 19, New York, NY, Blackwells Island, NYC Home for Aged and Infirm, Line 44: Patrick HART, inmate, age 68, single, born Ireland, parents born Ireland, immigrated 1860, naturalized, able to read and write, "yes" was in Civil War.
