August, age 18, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 262 as a private. August **died** 9 Mar 1863 at Young's Point, Louisiana. The Roll of Honor in the back of the Roster book lists August Hill as being buried at Vicksburg, Miss.
