

## Company G, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

HOWE, Hiram 15 Aug 1862

Hiram, age 22, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 262 as a private. He was discharged 16 July 1863 at Columbus OH on a Surgeon's certificate of disability.

Father: Peter HOWE

Mother: Sarah MEACH

Birth: 2 Aug 1840, Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH

Marriage: Mary B. FERGUSON, 7 Jun 1864, Summit Co. OH

Death: 18 May 1874, Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH

Cemetery: Doylestown Methodist Cemetery, Doylestown OH

I could not find this grave. Find a Grave says only 4 stones remain in this cemetery.

Pension index: Hiram HOWE, Co G 120th OVI, widow Mary B but the date is hard to read...she may have filed for the pension in 10 Jan 1877, Application 229482; Certificate 181329 . Also there is a filing for a minor by a guardian, David P. Kidwill, 19 June 1883, Application 305959; Certificate 204446.

Wayne Co. Graves Registration Cards book:

Hiram HOWE: address Chippewa Twp., Wayne co OH. Died 18 May 1874 at Chippewa twp.

He was born 2 Aug 1840 in Chippewa Twp. He is buried in the Methodist Cemetery, Doylestown OH. Lot 50, block 1, grave 6.

1850 Federal Census page 236, Chippewa Township, Wayne co OH, page 236: Peter Howe, age 45, a shoemaker listed with, Sarah (36), Alithia (18), Abell (male15), Peter (14), Hiram (10), Charity (7), Oscar (4), Isaac (4 months). The children were all born in OH.

[Peter and Sarah HOWE are buried in Chestnut Hill Cemetery, Chippewa Twp, Wayne co OH. Ohio Marriages: Peter HOWE married Sarah MEACH on 10 May 1832 in Wayne Co OH.]

1860 Census, Peter HOWE, age 55 PA, boot and shoe maker; Sarah, age 46 NY; Hiram, age 19 OH, shoe maker; Cherity, age 17 OH; Osker, age 14 OH; Isaac, age 10 OH; Hannah J, age 6 OH; Sally, age 2 OH.

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed Hiram HOWE's residence as Chippewa, Wayne OH

Hiram Howe married Mary B. FERGUSON, 7 Jun 1864, in Summit Co. OH.

1870 census, Doylestown, Chippewa Township, Wayne Co OH page 101: Hiram HOWE (29 OH) a shoemaker, Mary (27 PA), Alvira (5 OH), Catharine (3 OH), Andrew (1 OH).

Ohio, Deaths and Burials: Hiram HOWE died 18 May 1874 at Chippewa, Wayne OH at age 33, born 1842, Mer [?merchant], married.

1880 census Doylestown, Wayne County, Ohio Mary HOWE, widow, age 37, born in OH, parents born PA. She is listed as keeping house. With her are children: Alice age 15, Katie age 13, Andrew age 12, Henry age 10, and Samuel age 8. They were all born in OH as were their parents. Also living there is her mother-in-law Sarah Howe, age 66 born in CT as were both her parents.

Mary married David KIDWELL in about 1882 and they lived in Akron. They had a child Lillie Belle.

Ohio Marriages: D. P. KIDWELL married Mary B. HOWE on 2 Jan 1883 in Summit Co OH. Ohio Death record: Mary Belle KIDWELL, wife of David P. KIDWELL, father Caleb FERGUSON born PA, mother Catherine THOMAS, born America. Widow. Born 2 Feb 1842, Summit Co OH. Died 24 Dec 1928 at Sandusky, Erie Co OH. Home address 260 E. Market St. Burial at Doylestown, OH.

1900 Census, 1188 E. Broadway, Akron, Summit Co OH, Dwelling 16, Family 17: T. P. KIDWELL, age 58 England, born Sep 1841, parents born England, married 18 yrs, came to US in 1881, in US for 19 yrs, alien status, Salesman of ?pianos; Mary B, wife, age 61 OH, born March 1839, parents born PA, married 18 yrs, 6 children/5 still living; Henry HOWE, step son, age 29 OH, single, born June 1870, father born PA, mother born OH, woodworker, wagon??; Lillie KIDWELL, daughter, age 17 OH, single, born March 1883, fathre born Eng, mother born OH; Maud SAMUELS, grand daughter, age 14 OH, born Apr 1886, parents born OH; Warren BRIGHTMAN, boarder, age 8 OH, born June 1891, parents born OH.
