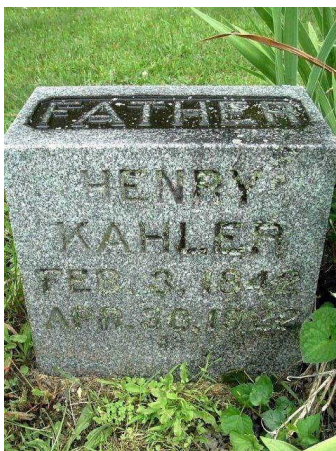


## Company G, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

KAHLER, Henry 20 Aug 1862 KOEHLER Henry, age 20, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 262 as a private. Transferred to the Veteran Reserve Corps on 1 Sep 1863.

Mother: Catherine KRUMROY  
Birth: 3 Feb 1842 [on stone at cemetery]

Marriage: Flora Ann SNYDER, 4 Apr 1871 [license issued 23 Dec 1870]  
Death: 30 Apr 1922 [on stone at

cemetery]

Cemetery: Burr Oak Cemetery, Athens, MI

Relationship: Brother in law of Samuel LUDWICK of Co G 120th OVI

From Lynn: Henry KAHLER, of the 120th Ohio, is Lynn's great grandfather. He is buried at Burr Oak Cemetery, Athens, Michigan. He died April 10 1921, and his wife, Flora Ann SNYDER, died May 4, 1911.

Henry's mother was Catherine KRUMROY. The Snyder family also were

from Ohio. The Kahlers changed the spelling of their name...was Koehler...Henry changed to Kahler when he went into the Army. One of his male children reverted back to the Koehler spelling in Michigan. Samuel LUDWICK, also of this Company G, married Henry KAHLER's sister Lucy.

1850 Census, Franklin Twp, Summit Co OH, Dwelling 2610, Family 2633: Jacob KOEHLER, age 40 Germany, farmer; Catharine, age 40 Germany; Eliza, age 16 OH; John, age 10 OH; Henry, age 8 OH; Louisa Ann, age 6 OH; Franklin, age 3 OH; Jefferson, age 7 months OH.

1860 census, Franklin Twp, Summit Co OH, Dwelling 384, Family 380: Jacob Kahler (50 Bavaria) a farmer, Catharine (50 Bavaria), Henry (18 OH) a farm laborer, Louise (16 OH) a domestic, Franklin (13 OH), Jefferson (11 OH).

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed Henry KAHLER's residence as Chippewa, Wayne OH

1870 Census, Franklin Twp, Summit Co OH, Dwelling 88, Family 84: Jacob Kahler, age 60 Bavaria, shoemaker.

Franklin Twp, Summit Co OH, Dwelling 89, Family 85: William GRILL, age 39 PA, farmer; Eliza, age 32 OH; John H, age 9 OH; Mary, age 8 OH; Charles, age 6 OH; Henry KAHLER, age 28 OH, farm laborer; Jefferson KAHLER, age 21 OH, shoemaker; Flora A. STINER, age 16 OH, domestic servant; Philip GRILL, age 46 PA, marked "dumb"; Sarah, age 75 PA.

Ohio Marriages: Henry KAHLER married Flora SNYDER, 4 Apr 1871, Summit Co OH.

1880 Census, Franklin, Summit County OH: Henry Kahler, age 38 born OH a farmer. His parents were born in Prussia. His wife was Flora A. age 27 born in OH. Her parents were born in PA. The children were William H age 7, Mary C. age 9, Charles E. age 5, Oliver F. age 2, Harvey J. age 3 months. All the children were born in OH.

1890 Veterans Schedule Record: Athens, MI Lines 16 and 17, House 323, Family 324, Henry KAHLER, Private, Co G 120th OH Inf. and Co A 5th Veterans Reserve Corps, disabilities rheumatism, catarrh, chronic diarrhoea, post office Athens, Calhoun Co MI.

1900 Census, Series: T623 Roll: 704, Athens Twp, Calhoun Co, MI, page 70: Henry KAHLER, age 58 OH,

born Feb 1842, married 30 yrs, farmer, parents born Germany; Flora A, wife, age 46 OH, born Nov 1853, married 30 yrs, 7 children/7 still living; Mary, daughter, age 29 OH, born Mar 1871, single; Oliver F, son, age 22 OH, born Dec 1877, single, saw mill laborer; Harvey E, son, age 19 OH, born Mar 1881, single, farm laborer; Leo, son, age 17 MI, born Nov 1882; Eugene, son, age 14 MI, born July 1885.

1910 Census, Series: T624 Roll: 639, Athens Twp, Calhoun Co, MI, page 71: Henry KAHLER, age 68 OH, first marriage, married 49 yrs, general farmer, parents born Germany, Column 30 marked UA for service in Union Army; Laura, wife, age 56 OH, first marriage, married 49 yrs, 7 children/6 still living, parents born OH; Mary, daughter, age 38 OH, single; Oliver, son, age 24 OH, single, farm laborer.

1920 Census, Series: T625 Roll: 758, Sherwood?, Branch County, MI, page 232: James L FORD, age 65 MI, truck farmer, parents born NY; Mary C, wife, age 48 OH, parents born OH; Henry Kahler, father in law, age 77 OH, widowed, parents born Germany, no occupation.
