Harmon, age 20, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 262 as a private.

Transferred to Co. K 114th OVI 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co E, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 14 Oct 1865.
