

Company G, 120th Ohio Volunteer Infantry

LINK, Joseph* 22 Aug 1862

Joseph, age 23, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 262 as a private.

Joseph **died** 12 July 1863 at Black River, Mississippi. The Roll of Honor in the back of the Roster book lists Joseph Link as being buried at Vicksburg, Miss.

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed Joseph LINK's residence as Chippewa, Wayne OH

1870 Census, Series: M593 Roll: 1280, Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH, page 81: Nichoas LINK, age 60 France, farmer; Bridget, age 53 Baden; Andrew, age 20 OH farm laborer; Louis, age 15 OH; George, age 13 OH; William, age 11 OH. [Family Search: Bridget Mary's maiden name was FRIEDMAN. The family later moved to Stark Co OH. Buried St. Peter Paul Cemetery, Canton OH. I wonder if there is any kind of marker there for Joseph.]
