LANGLEY, Edmund 17 Oct 1862 LANGLEY LANGLY  
Edmund, age 27, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 260 as a Sergeant. Birth: <1833 - 1835>  
He was discharged 25 Mar 1863 at Covington Kentucky on a Surgeon's certificate of disability.

Apparently Edmund went to Cincinnati, Hamilton Co OH

Enlisted in 120th 17 Oct 1862

Listed in Wooster Republican with a list of men in Company G, Thursday, 1 Jan 1863, as Edmund LANGLEY of Cincinnati

Wife Mary must have died, but when and where? Between 1861 and June 1863.

I have been unable to find Edmund in the census records for 1850, 1860, 1870, or 1880.
