LUDWICK, Samuel 22 Aug 1862
Samuel, age 21, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 262 as a private. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River in Louisiana. He mustered out 7 July 1865 at Camp Chase OH by order of the War Department.

Pension index: Samuel Ludwick of Co G 120th OVI, Invalid pension 5 May 1880, Application 361313; Certificate 255632, Widow's pension, Lucy A, 21 May 1910, Application 942543; Certificate 704859, filed in Michigan

Michigan, Deaths and Burials: Samuel LUDWICK died 13 May 1910 at Carson City, Montcalm Co MI, age 69. Born 1841. Retired farmer. Married. Father Samuel LUDWICK and Marietta DICK.

Sons of Union Veterans: Samuel LUDWICK, born 1841. Burial Vermillion Cem, SR 60, Hayesville, Vermillion Twp, Ashland County OH. [There is a note that no stone was found but there was a GAR flag holder.] Why would his flag holder be in Ashland County? This flag holder is shown at [Find a Grave](#). But the flag holder says Regiment Unknown. There was a Samuel Ludwick/Ludwig in the 44th Indiana, so it is not likely to be at his grave, but it could be. The Samuel LUDWICK/LUDWIG of the 120th OH was also in the 114th OH. There are no other soldiers by that name listed at Civil War Soldiers and Sailors System.]

1850 Census, Franklin Twp, Summit Co OH, Dwelling 2660, Family 2683: Samuel LUDWICK, age 48 PA, farmer; Mary, age 39 PA; George, age 19 OH, farmer; Eve, age 17 OH; Barbara, age 15 OH; Rachel, age 13 OH; Mary E., age 11 OH; Samuel, age 9 OH; Rebecca, age 7 OH; Vernon P, age 5 OH; Jemima, age 3 OH; Anna, age 1 OH; Levi LUDWICK, age 22 OH, farmer.

1860 Census, Series: M653 Roll: 1039, Franklin Twp, Summit Co OH, page 154: Samuel LUDWIG, age 15 OH, farm laborer and Anna LUDWIG, age 10 OH, are living with the Martin [29 PA] and Rachel [23 OH] GRILL family. [I have found at Family Search that Rachel LUDWICK married Martin GRILL and her parents were Samuel LUDWICK and Mary DICK.]

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed Samuel LUDWICK's residence as Chippewa, Wayne OH

Summit County OH Probate: Samuel Ludwick married Lucy A. Kaler on 20 Aug 1865. [Note: Lucy was the sister of Henry KAHLER, also of this Company G.]

1870 Census, Series: M593 Roll: 692, Bloomer Twp, Montcalm Co MI, page 8: Samiel LUDWICK, age 29 OH, farmer; Lucy, age 26 OH; Annie, age 3 OH; Frank, age 1 MI.

In the 1880 census New Haven, Gratiot County, Michigan, Samuel Ludwick age 39 born OH, is a farmer. His parents were born in PA. His wife Lucy age 36 born in OH. Her parents born Bavaria. Children: Anna age 12 born OH; Frank age 11 born MI; Mary age 8 born MI; Luella age 5 born MI; and Willis age 1 born MI.

1890 Veterans Schedule: New Haven, Gratiot Co MI: Line 23, House 80, Family 80: Samuel LUDWICK, Pvt, Co G 120 OVI. Post Office: Carson city, Montcalm Co MI. Defective eyesight. 13 months in Rebel Prison.

1900 Census, Series: T623 Roll: 712, New Haven Twp, Gratiot Co MI, page 174: Samuel LUDWICK, age 59 OH the index says, but can barely make out the last name myself....on the next page are listed the following: Willis H, son, age 21 MI, single, born Mar 1879, farm laborer, parents born OH; Pearl E, daughter, age 17 MI, born Apr 1883, parents born OH; Clio H, son, age 11 MI, born Dec 1888, parents born OH.

1910 Census, enumerated 19 April 1910, Series: T624 Roll: 665, Bloomer Twp, Montcalm Co MI, page 32: Samuel LUDWICK, age 69 OH, first marriage, married 44 yrs, no occupation, parents born PA; Lucy, wife, age 66 OH, first marriage, married 44 yrs, 7 children/7 still living, parents born Germany; Mary, daughter, age 38 MI, single; Pearle MORSE, age 26 MI, widow; Grace LUDWICK, daughter [Must have been a grand daughter], age 5 MI, parents born MI.
