MANSFIELD, Abraham\* 21 Aug 1862

Abraham, age 27, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 262 as a private. Abraham died 2 May 1863 at St. Louis, Missouri. The Roll of Honor in the back of the Roster book lists the same cemetery for Abraham. It gives the location as section 6, grave 7

[This is probably an old numbering system for the cemetery.] Buried at [Jefferson Barracks National Cemetery](#), St Louis Missouri...died and buried 2 May 1863, US Army, Private. Plot 6 0 7549

Pension index: Abraham Mansfield shows a widow Elizabeth Pension Card: Widow applied 7 July 1863, Application 26.826; Certificate 10.899; and a guardian J. Baysinger, 30 Mar 1867, Application 144,792; Certificate 118,898.

1850 Census, Wadsworth, Medina Co OH, Dwelling 266, Family 273: Abram KEPHART, age 20 PA, laborer; Daniel SNIDER, age 30 PA, farmer; Maria SNIDER, age 27 MD; Abram MANSFIELD, age 13 OH.

Probate records Summit co OH: Abram MANSFIELD married Elizebeth HELWICK on 1 Nov 1857.

1860 census, Chippewa Twp, Wayne co OH, page 377: Abraham Mansfield (22 OH) day laborer, Elisabeth (24 OH), James E. (11 months OH), Sabrinah Mansfield (39KY).

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed Abraham MANSFIELD's residence as Chippewa.

Ohio Marriages: Elizabeth MANSFIELD married Michael BAYSINGER on 13 Sep 1866 in Summit Co OH.

Guardian: Jac. Baysinger [There was a Jacob BAYSINGER, age 46, living in Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH in 1870 and 1880. His wife was also named Eliza.]

1870 Census, Chippewa twp, Wayne Co OH, page 84 - 85: Mike BAYSINGER, age 35 OH, farm laborer; Eliza, age 28? OH; James MANSFIELD, age 11 OH; John MANSFIELD, age 9 OH; Samuel BAYSINGER, age 4 OH; William BAYSINGER, age 2 OH; Martha BAYSINGER, age 9 months OH, born in January 1869. They are all living in the household of Harvey [24 OH] and Amanda [24 OH] GALEHOUSE.

In 1880, Samuel BAYSINGER, is living with his uncle Abram BAYSINGER in Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH.....Dwelling 34, Family 37.

Where was the rest of the family???????

Was this Abraham's widow or is this Jacob Baysinger's wife? Ohio Obituary Index: Eliza BAYSINGER, died 28 Jan 1894 at Doylestown, age 70 listed at [Find a Grave](#) Born Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH.

Pension at fold3.com:

Abraham MANSFIELD died at Lawson Hospital, St. Louis, MO on 3 May 1863 of congestion of the lungs. Another paper says chronic diarrhoea was cause of death.

Elizabeth HELWICK and Abraham MANSFIELD were married in Summit Co OH on 1 Nov 1857. by R. G. MARSHALL Justice of the Peace. Another paper says that they were married at Johnson Corners, Medina Co OH.

Minor children: James Edward born 20 July 1859 and John Franklin born 12 Sep 1861. Dr. A. M. ARMSTRONG, of Wayne Co OH, was the physician in attendance at the birth of John F. Mansfield born 12 Sep 1861. Ann M HARTER was the midwife in attendance at the birth of James E. MANSFIELD on 20 July 1859.

Widow remarried 13 Sep 1866 to Michael BAYSINGER. Their post office was Easton, Wayne Co OH.

Jacob BAYSINGER was appointed guardian of the children. Dated 4 Sep 1866
