MARSHALL, Joseph 21 Aug 1862
Joseph, age 19, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 262 as a private.
He was transferred to Co. K 114th OVI 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co. E of the 48th OVI 24 July 1865. Mustered out at Houston TX 14 Oct 1865.
[Enlisted at Doylestown.....the Wayne County Roll of Honor in Hardesty's also says that Joseph Marshall was wounded at Black River Bridge.]

Catherine Riley, his wife: born 3 May 1843, married 27 Sep 1866, died 8 July 1924

Pension index: Joseph Marshall, G 120th OH Inf, E 48th OH Inf, K 114th OH Inf. Invalid pension 29 Dec 1879, Application 325597, Certificate 299502. Widow Catherine 26 Feb 1923, Application 1201320; Certificate 931563, filed in Indiana. Joseph died 11 Feb 1923 at Lafayette IN.

Can not find in 1850.

1860 census, Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH, page 370

Francis Marshell (38 MD) a farmer, Ellen (30 France), Joseph (17 OH) listed as "none" on occupation but was attending school, Henry (14 OH)

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed Joseph MARSHALL's residence as Chippewa.

Discharge record on microfilm at Wayne co OH, book 2, page 60:

Joseph Marshall of Co E 48th Ohio was born in Wayne Co OH. He enrolled at age 18, was 5' 5½" tall, with dark complexion, hazel eyes and black hair. He was a farmer. Oath of Identity was 17 Aug 1882 but residence was not given.

1870 Census, Series: M593 Roll: 1280, Doylestown, Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH, page 106: Joseph MARSHAL, age 26 OH, stone mason; Catharine, age 25 OH; Mary F.J.; age 2 OH; Clement, age 9 months, born Aug 1869; Henry, age 24 OH, teaching school; Andrew GARDHEFFNER, age 49 Bavaria, stone mason. [Note: Andrew GARDHEFFNER is the step-father of Joseph MARSHALL....see Andrew GARDHEFFNER of this Company G above.]

In the 1870 census, Andrew Gardhefner, age 49, is living in the household of his step-son and fellow Civil War veteran, Joseph Marshall. Others in the household are Joseph's wife Catherine, daughter Mary Frances, son Clement, and brother Henry. Both Joseph and Andrew are noted as being stone masons. Henry's occupation is given as teaching school. Andrew's birthplace is listed as Bavaria

The 1870 census was for Chippewa Twp., Wayne Co. And it was Joseph Marshall and Andrew Gardheffner who were the stone masons. [Joseph's younger brother Henry's occupation in 1870 was School Teacher. He had lost a leg in 1864 when he was 17 in a farm accident (a tree fell on him during land clearing). Consequently he attended High School in Canton. It seems likely that it was during this time that his mother, Helen SHONDEL Marshall, was married to Andrew Gardheffner. She had been widowed in March 1864 and died in September 1869. Henry went on to become the Wayne County Recorder and a Deputy Probate Judge.]

1880 Census, Series: T9 Roll: 1076, Doylestown, Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH, page 83: Joseph MARSHALL, age 36 OH, stone mason, parents birth left blank; Catherine, wife, age 35 OH, parents born Ireland; Mary, daughter, age 13 OH; Clement, son, age 10 OH; Chester, son, age 8 OH; Edward, son, age 5 OH.

1890 Veterans Schedule, Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH: Line 6, Joseph MARSHALL, Private, Co G 120 OVI, disability vertigo and nervous debility resulting from sunstroke. Post office Doylestown.

In the 1 June 1893 edition, Tri-County Weekly News - Doylestown, Ohio:

The 120th OVI will hold 25th reunion at Mansfield O. on Tuesday, June 13 and Memorial Day Decorations of soldiers graves in Doylestown on Tuesday May 30, 1892 - Chestnut Hill cemetery by the G.A.R. ex-soldiers present [Marshall, Joseph Co. G 120 OVI included in list]

1900 Census, Series: T9 Roll: 1076, Doylestown, Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH, page 78: Joseph MARSHALL, age 57 OH, married 34 yrs, born Mar 1843, parents born Germany; Catherine, wife, age 56 OH, married 34 yrs, born May 1844, 5 children/2 still living, parents born Ireland; Charles, son, age 16 OH, born June 1883.

1910 Census, Series: T624 Roll: 1239, Doylestown, Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH, page 82: Joseph MARSHALL, age 66 OH, first marriage, married 43 yrs, father born OH, mother born France, spoke German, mason doing odd jobs, column 30 marked UA for military service; Catharine, wife, age 66 OH, first marriage, married 43 yrs, 5 children/3 still living, parents born Ireland.

1920 Census, Series: T625 Roll: 1448, Doylestown, Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH, page 81: Joseph MARSHALL, age 77 OH, retired farmer, parents born PA, Catherine, age 77 OH, parents born Ireland.

Brother's Ohio Death record: Henry MARSHALL died 23 Dec 1913 at Wooster, Wayne Co OH. Born 24 May 1846 in Doylestown OH. Married. Retired. Burial Doylestown Cem. Father Francis MARSHALL, born PA. Mother Helena SCHONDEL, born France.
