McCRANE, Cornelius* 16 Aug 1862 ?McCRONE

Cornelius, age 18, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 262 as a private.

Cornelius **died** 9 Mar 1863 at Young's Point, Louisiana. The Roll of Honor in the back of the Roster book lists Cornelius McCrane as being buried at Vicksburg, Miss.

Cemetery: Vicksburg National Cemetery [not listed] Probably buried there as an unknown.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Cornelius McCracken, Private, Co G 120th OH Inf, died 8 Mar 1863 on floating hospital "Nashville" Cause: diarrhoea.

Have not found on Burial Registers, Military Posts and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960.

Not on National Cemetery Interment Control Forms, 1928-1962

Not on Pension Index.

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed C. McCRAHN's residence as Loudonville.

???1850 Census, Cass Twp, Richland Co OH, Dwelling 24, Family 24: Thomas McCrone, age 36 Ireland, laborer on railroad; Ellen, age 24 Ireland; Ellen, age 8 Ireland; Cornelius, age 6 Ireland; Catharine, age one Canada.
