MURRY, John 28 July 1862 MURRAY
John, age 32, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 262 as a private.

He was discharged 28 Mar 1864 at Camp Dennison, OH on a Surgeon's certificate of disability.

Headstones Provided for Deceased Union Civil War Veterans, 1879-1903:
John MURRAY, Pvt, Co G 120th OH Inf. Cemetery village of Burbank or Fredericksburg, Wayne Co OH. Died 12 Jan 1875. Contract dated 25 Nov 1884.

Discharge Records on microfilm at Wayne Co OH, Book 1, page 343:

John Murry of Co G 120th OVI was born in England. He was 32 at the time of his enrollment. 5' 7" tall, sandy complexion, blue eyes, sandy hair.....a farmer.

There is a note about his disability saying that he had chronic diarrhea; functional disease of the heart, congenital deformity of the chest and was unfit for the invalid corps.

The Oath of Identity was dated 3 Feb 1866 and his residence was Fredericksburg, Wayne Co OH.

1860 Census, Franklin Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 1045?, Family 1066: John MURRY, age 29 Ireland, laborer; Jane, age 35 PA; Thomas, age 4 OH; William, age one, OH; James WILLIS, age 11, PA.

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed John MURRY's residence as Wooster.

1870 Census, Salt Creek Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 172, Family 170: John MURRY, age 40 Ireland, farmer; [next page] Jane, age 45 PA; Thomas, age 14 OH; William, age 11 OH.

Wayne graves Registration Cards book:

John Murry of Co G 120th, address Wayne co OH. He died 12 Aug 1875 at Wayne co OH. He was born in 1826 in Ireland. He is buried in East Side cemetery in Fredericksburg, OH. Lot 46, Block 8, Grave 1

Death record: John MURRY died 12 Aug 1875 at Salt Creek, Wayne Co OH. Age 48. Born 1827 in Ireland. Married.

1890 Veterans Schedule: Canton, Stark Co OH: Line 44, House 232, Family 240, Jane Ann widow of John MURRAY, Pvt. Co G 120th OH Inf. Post Office Canton, OH

Wife's Ohio, Death and Burials: Jane A. MURRAY died 14 Feb 1899 at Stark Co OH, age 69. Born 1830 in PA. Housekeeper. Widow.

Son's Ohio Death Record: William L. MURRAY died 31 Oct 1918 at Cleveland, Cuyahoga Co OH at age 59y, 3m, 15d. Born 17 Jul 1859 in OH. Night watchman. Burial Canton OH. Father John MURRAY, born Ireland. Mother Jane METHOVEN. [Go back and view image.]
