

Company G, 120th Ohio Volunteer Infantry

MUSSER, Samuel 21 Aug 1862

Samuel, age 24, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 262 as a private. No comments listed in the Roster.

Father: Henry MUSSER

Mother: Mary KNOWL [DeborahMcKay1955 at Ancestry.com]

Birth: Jan 1838 OH

Marriage: Mary Ann BROUSE, 28 Nov 1861, Wayne Co OH

Death: 30 April 1905

Cemetery: Chestnut Hill Cemetery, Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH

Relationship: Brother in law of Jacob, F. Reason, and William BROUSE of Co G 120th OVI.

Mary A. Musser, 1842 - 1913, is buried there also. This date agrees with the approximate birth year from the 1850 census for Mary A. Brouse, sister of the Brouse brothers of Co G.

1860 Census, Paris Twp, Stark Co CCC OH, Dwelling 183, Family 177: Henry MUSSER, age 64 PA, farmer; Mary, age 60 PA; William, age 22 OH; Samuel, age 21 OH; Joseph, age 20 OH; Emanuel, age 17 OH; Nancy, age 15 OH; David, age 13 OH; Mary, age 24? OH.

Ohio, County Marriages: Samuel Musser married Mary Ann Brouse on 28 Nov. 1861 in Wayne co. OH (probate record) Sister of the BROUSE brothers of Company G.

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed Samuel MUSSER's residence as Chippewa.

Samuel and Mary must have gone to Canada for awhile since son was born there in about 1865:

1880 census Doylestown, Wayne county Ohio: Samuel Musser age 42 born in OH, a teamster. His parents were both born in OH. His wife Mary, age 38 born OH. Her parents were both born in OH. Son Charles age 15 was born in Canada...he is also listed as a teamster. Daughter Harriet age 3 born in OH.

1900 Census, Doylestown, Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 17, Family 17: Samuel MUSSER, age 62 OH, born Jan 1838, married 39 yrs, parents born PA, school janitor; Mary, wife, age 57 OH, born Nov 1842, married 39 yrs, 4 children/2 still living, parents born OH; Harriet, daughter, age 23 OH, single, born Dec 1876, dress maker.

Short obituary found in Wayne County Democrat, 3 May 1905, page 6

Samuel Musser, aged 67 years, an old soldier, died Sunday, after a long illness with stomach trouble, at his home in Doylestown, where he resided many years.

[Using a date calculator, the date he died would have been 30 April 1905 if he died the Sunday before the date of the newspaper.]

Wife, Ohio Deaths: Mary Ann MUSSER died 5 Jun 1913 at Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH. Born 11 Nov 1842 OH. Widow. Burial Chestnut Hill Cem. Father John BROUSE, born PA. Mother Harriett FREDRICK, born OH.
