

Company G, 120th Ohio Volunteer Infantry

NAUMAN, Frederick 22 Aug 1862

Frederick, age 23, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 262 as a private. He was transferred to Co. K 114th OVI 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co.E of the 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out with that company on 14 Oct 1865.

Marriage: Catherine PUTMAN, 10 Mar 1866, Stark Co OH

Death: 26 Jul 1909 at Sugar Creek Twp, Stark Co OH

Relationship: Brother of Jacob NAUMAN of Co G 120th OVI

Pension Card: Frederick NAUMAN, Co G 120th OH Inf, K 114th OH Inf., Co E 48th OH Inf. Invalid filed 9 June 1890, Application 781.333; Certificate 550.145 Frederick died 1909

Came to USA in 1854.

1860 census Chippewa Twp, Wayne OH, page 383

Jacob Nowman (56 Prussia) a farmer, Lewis (26 Prussia) a coal miner, William (23 Prussia) coal miner, Fredrick (20 Prussia) a farm hand, Catherine (16 Prussia), Mary (15 Prussia), Charles (12 Prussia).

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed Frederick NAUMAN's residence as Chippewa.

Discharge Records on microfilm at Wayne County OH, Book 1 page 594:

Frederick Nauman of Co E 48th OVI was discharged at Houston TX. He was born in Prussia. He was age 23 when he enrolled. He was 5' 5½", fair complexion, blue eyes, dark hair. He was a farmer. The Oath of Identity was not filled out.

This is from Jerry Nauman, descendant of Frederick: Frederick Nauman is my Great great grandfather. He was married to Catherine PUTMAN daughter of J and F PUTMAN of Wilmont, Ohio.

Ohio Marriages: Frederick NAUMAN married Catharine PUTTMAN, 10 Mar 1866 in Stark Co OH.

1870 Census, Series: M593 Roll: 1269, Sugar Creek Twp, Stark Co OH, page 601: Frederick NAUMAN, age 30 Prussia, farmer; Catherine, age 26 OH; Mary, age 2 OH; Martha, age one month OH, born in April.

1880 Census, haven't found yet.

1890 Veterans Schedule: Sugar Creek Twp, Stark Co OH: Line 49 and 50, House 341, Family 354:

Frederick NAUMAN, Pvt, Co G 120th OH Inf and Co K 114th OH Inf. Post Office: Wilmot.

In the newspaper report of the 1900 reunion of the 120th, Frederick Nauman was reported to be living in Wilmot. I found a Wilmot in Stark county in that time period..

1900 Census, Series: T623 Roll: 1323, Sugar Creek Twp, Stark Co OH, page 253: Frederick NAUMANN, age 61 Germany, no occupation listed, emigrated in 1854, resided in US 46 yrs, Na; born July 1839, married 34 yrs, parents born Germany; Catherine, wife, age 56 OH, born May 1844, married 34 yrs, 4 children/4 still living, parents born PA; Clarence E, son, age 20 OH, single, born Nov 1879, student.

Death record in Ohio: Frederick NAUMANN, died 26 Jul 1909 at Sugar Creek Twp, Stark Co OH. Born 3 Jul 1839 in Prussia. Married. Farmer. Burial at Green Lawn Cemetery, Wilmot OH. Father Jacob NAUMANN, born Prussia. Mother Sophia HONEEKER born Prussia.

Wife Death record in Ohio: Mary NAUMANN died 18 Mar 1914 at Wilmot, Stark Co OH. Born 13 May 1838 at Wilmot, OH. Widow. Buried Green Lawn Cem, Wilmot OH. Father Joseph PUTMAN born PA. Mother Elizabeth PUTMAN.
