POLLOCK, James R. 22 Aug 1862 See also in [Company I](#).

James, age 24, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 260 as 1st Lieutenant. He was promoted from 1st Sergeant Co. I 120th OVI on 12 Oct 1864. He was transferred to Co. E, 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co F, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 14 Oct 1865. James was also in Co H 15th OH Inf. [In the 15th OH for 3 months in 1861 as a Private]

Ohio, County Marriages: J R POLLOCK married Jennie S CREIGH on 7 Mar 1867 in Richland county OH.

1870 Census, Madison Twp, Richland Co OH, Dwelling 70, Family 67: James POLLOCK, age 32 OH, farmer; Jennie, age 24 OH; Clyde C., age 1 OH; Mary UNDERWOOD, age 13 OH.

History of Richland County, Ohio: Its Past and Present, comp. & pub. by A.A. Graham (1880), pp. 697-698: David M. CREIGH married Attilia BARR in 1845 and they had three children. The eldest, Jennie, the wife of James R. POLLOCK died 11 Nov 1877, age 30 years 10 months and 29 days, leaving one son; p. 512: "The Western Suspender Company was established in 1871, by B.O. FOSTER and J.R. POLLOCK. In a short time Mr. POLLOCK purchased the interest of Foster, and, in January 1873, took in J.P. RUMMEL as partner. This firm conducted the business successfully until August 5, 1879, when Mr. RUMMEL purchased the entire establishment...." [Note: J(oseph) P. Rummel also served in Co. B of the 120th Ohio]; p. 360: A roster of the officers in the 120th O.V.I. who were from Richland County, OH includes First Lt. James R. POLLOCK, whose date of rank was 12 Oct 1864, the same day his commission was issued. [Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

James R. POLLOCK first appears in Mansfield, OH city directories in 1871 when his occupation is listed as suspender mfg. and his residence is 126 N. Mulberry. He is also listed in 1873, 1877, 1881, 1883 and 1884. In 1881 and 1883 he is listed as a farmer with a home at 89 W. Fourth. James does not appear in 1886 or 1891, but he reappears in 1894 and 1895, both times being listed as a traveling salesman whose residence was 235 Marion ave. James does not appear in Mansfield directories published after 1895. [Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

1880 Census, Mansfield, Richland Co OH, Dwelling 26, Family 37: James POLLOCK, age 42 OH, father born Ireland, mother born PA, retired farmer; Clyde, son, age 11 OH, parents born OH; Fanny, mother, age 79 PA, parents born PA; Margaret, sister, age 50 OH, father born Ireland, mother born PA.

Mother, Ohio, Deaths and Burials: Fanny POLLOCK died 4 Feb 1885 at Pennsylvania at age 83. Born 1802 in PA???, but her residence was Mansfield OH. [Note: burial Mansfield cemetery, lot 728, section OS-12 with husband]

J.R. POLLOCK, of Mansfield, served as Asst. Marshall at the 18th Annual Reunion of the 120th O.V.I. held at Au's grove in Richland Co., OH in 1886. [Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

POLLOCK, age 31 OH, born Oct 1868, parents born OH, livery man; Jessie P., wife, age 22 OH, born Jun 1877, 0 children, married 0 yrs, parents born OH; Margaret J. POLLOCK, age 77 OH, born Jul 1822, aunt, father born Ireland, mother born PA.

Son, Ohio, Deaths: Clyde Creigh POLLOCK died 9 Dec 1941, Mansfield, Richland Co OH. Married. Policeman. Born 16 Oct 1868, Richland Co OH. Cemetery: Mansfield. Father James R. POLLOCK born Mansfield OH. Mother Jennie CREIGH, born Mansfield OH.
