John, age 19, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 262 as a private. He transferred to 120th Co., 2nd Battalion, Veteran Reserve Corps 24 Dec 1863. He was discharged 31 Mar 1864 at Evansville, Indiana on a Surgeon's certificate of disability.
