SIMMONS, Henry 22 Aug 1862
Henry, age 18, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 262 as a private. He mustered out 31 May 1865 at Camp Dennison OH by order of the War department.

But he may be buried at Old Zion Lutheran Cem, Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH.

Wayne County burials book...in the section at the back of the book for additions and

corrections: Old Zion Lutheran Cemetery in Chippewa Township, Wayne Co OH Henry Simmons, 1866, age 22, son of M. & M. This would be Doylestown Lutheran Church on north side of East Clinton St. [no indication of military service for Henry]

Wayne Co Graves Registration Cards book: [I believe this information is not correct. Henry is being confused with his brother Samuel.] Henry Simmons of Co G 120th, address Wayne Co, died September 1888. He was born in 1846. He is buried at Chestnut Hill, Chippewa twp. Wayne OH in Lot 1, Block 8, Grave 7. Wayne County Cemetery Book: Buried at Chestnut Hill in Chippewa Twp are:
Michael Simmons, died 2 Dec 1901, age 80 yrs, 8 months, 5 dys
Mary M. his wife, died 8 Ap 1909
The book said that Samuel died 9 Sept 1868, age 42 [Note: I saw this stone. The year was read incorrectly. It is 1888. [See inset in photo of gravestone.]

1850 Census, Lawrence Twp, Stark Co OH, Dwelling 285, Family 294: Michl SIMMONS, age 36 Germany, farmer; Mary, age 31 OH; Sarah, age 11 OH; Susan, age 10 OH; Henry, age 8 OH; Saml, age 4 OH; John, age 18 OH. [Possible parents' marriage: Michael SIMMON married Mary MILLER on 21 Apr 1836 at Stark Co OH.]

1860 Census, Chippewa Twp, Wayne co OH, page 366

Michael Simmons (49 France) a farmer, Mary (38 PA), Henry (17 OH) a farm hand, Samuel (14OH), John (11 OH), a boy Elies (7 OH). Louisa J. (5 OH), Flore E. (3 OH), Josiah (3 months OH), Margret Simmons (but may actually be spelled Simones here) (age 82 France).

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed Henry SIMMONS' residence as Chippewa.

Sister's death record: Ohio, Deaths: Flora A. LICKS born 4 Oct 1857 at Doylestown OH; father Michael SIMON born Germany, mother Mary MILLER born PA. Spouse Conrad. Died 24 Jul 1936 at Barberton, Summit, OH. Widow. Burial Doylestown. Informant Verlie LICKS of Barberton OH.
