STORY, Francis 21 Nov 1863 Franklin STORY

Francis, age 23, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 262 as a Private. He was transferred to Co. D[on roster] or K [on pension index] 114th OVI 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co D 48th OH 24 July 1865.[Franklin Story] Mustered out 25 Oct 1865. Discharged at Columbus OH 26 June 1866.

Father: Jakob STOERI

Mother: Anna LIGLER

Birth: Haetzingen, Switzerland on 14 Apr 1839

Marriage: Katarina SCHULER, 28 June 1860 in Betschwanden, Switzerland

Death: 10 or 29 May 1893 at Lexington, Fayette Co KY

Cemetery: NOT at Marion National Cem. in Indiana. [NOT at St. James City Cem, Phelps Co IN.](#)

Pension Index: Franklin STORY, Co D 48th and K 114th and G 120th OH Inf.

Invalid pension filed in IN 22 Oct 1892, Application 1135455, no certificate. Minor pension applied in MO 12 June 1893, Application 578353, Certificate 428184. [Jacob Story was living in Phelps Co MO when he applied for the pension to support the sisters on 7 June 1893.]

Not in Headstones record.

In pension papers: On 28 June 1860 in Betschwanden, Switz., Franz STOERI, a tailor and son of Jakob STOERI and Anna LIGLER, married Katarina SCHULER. Franz was born in Haetzingen on 14 Apr 1839 and was single. Katarina was single, born 16 Feb 1841 and was the daughter of Fridolin SCHULER and R. MARIA.

Franklin did not come to the US until after 6 Feb 1861.

1870 Census, have not found.

1880 Census, Town of St James, Phelps Co MO, Dwelling 67, Family 72, page 330-331: Frank STORI, age 41 Switzerland, tailor, parents born Switz.; Catherine, wife, age 39 Switzerland, parents born Switz.; Jacob, son, age 19 Switzerland, barber, parents born Switz.; Frank, son, age 10 IL, parents born Switz.; Mary A, age 9 months MO, born Aug 1879, daughter, parents born Switz.

Did not find in 1890 Veterans Schedule.

Wife, Catherine, died 26 Mar 1887 and is buried at St. James City Cemetery, Phelps Co MO, along with three unnamed children. Soldier Franklin not listed.

Franklin died 10 May 1893 of pneumonia at St. Joseph's Hospital in Lexington, KY.

Two daughters, Anna L. and Mary A. died as minors. Their brother Jacob, the oldest of Franklin's children, was their guardian. Mary Alice was born 18 Aug 1879. Anna L. was born 15 Mar 1884.

Son, [Benjamin Franklin STORY](#) [wife Laura M.] died in Phelps Co MO on 24 June 1938, born 4 July 1869 in Greenville, [Bond Co] IL, buried at Asher Cem. Son Jacob stated in pension letter that the two girls had been married when young. Wife Catherine Story died 26 Mar 1887, buried at [Saint James Cem](#), Phelps Co MO.

National Homes for Disabled Soldiers, 1866-1938: Marion Branch

Marion, Grant Co IN Franklin STORY, enlisted 1 Nov 1863 at Wooster O. Co G 120th OH Inf., discharged 27 Nov 1864 transferred. Co K 114th OH Inf., discharged 24 July 1865, transferred. Co D 48th OH Inf., discharged 9 May 1866 at Galveston TX, services no longer required. Private. Born Switzerland. Age 53. Ht 5'8", dark complexion. Could read and write. Occupation: tailor. Residence subsequent to discharge, Marion IN. Widowed. Nearest relative: Jacob STORY, St. James, Phelps Co, MO. Date of admission 28 Nov. 1892. Died 29 May 1893 at St. Josephs Hospital, Lexington, KY of pneumonia.

Lexington and Fayette Co. Medical Society stated that Franklin Story died of pneumonia at St. Joseph's Hospital 10 May 1893 at Lexington KY. According to pension paperwork, Franklin did apply for an invalid pension but did not live to complete the claim.

In 1900 Anna STORY, daughter of Francis, was living in a Masonic Home. She was born Mar 1884.

Death record of J. Jacob STORY, son of Frank STORY and Anna Katharine SCHULER. Frank was born in Hatzingen, [Glarus Canton], Switzerland. Anna was also born in Switzerland. J. Jacob was born 6 Feb 1861 in Switzerland and died 17 Mar 1942 in St. Louis MO. [1930 Census, St Louis, St. Louis, MO: Jacob STORY, age 69 Switz., lodging in what looks to be a boarding house.] John Jacob STORY is buried at [Saint James Cemetery](#), Phelps Co, MO.
