STOTTLER, Franklin 19 Aug 1862 John F STOTLER Franklin, age 19, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 260 as 2nd Lieutenant. He was appointed Sergeant from Corporal 18 Jan 1863 and to 1st Sergeant 12 Ap 1863. He became a 2nd Lieutenant on 14 Mar 1863. He resigned 12 July 1863.

1880 census Chippewa, Wayne County OH...the only Frank Stotler that fits was found living with his father and had apparently not been married yet at this point.:

Emanuel Stotler, age 68 born in PA, is a farmer. His parents were born PA. Wife Eliza age 60 born OH. Her parents were born in PA. Son Frank Stotler, age 35 born OH, is a bookkeeper and is listed as single. His father was born in PA and his mother in OH. Son Charles age 23 born in OH is a farm laborer. Daughter Cora M. Stotler age 19 born in OH. All the children were listed as single.

1884 marriage Caroline...[Ohio Marriages: J. F. STAFTER/STABLER married Caroline WHITMAN on 27 Nov 1884 at Wayne Co OH.]

1890 Veterans Schedule, Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co OH: Line 3, House 11, Family 12, Franklin J. STOTTLER, Second Lieutenant, Co G 120th OVI, disability chronic diarrhea, post office Doylestown, reenlisted as 100 day man five months.

1900 Census, T623 Roll: 1331, Chippewa Twp, Wayne Co, OH, page 78: Frank STOTTLER, age 55 OH, born Nov 1844, married 15 yrs, no occupation listed, parents born OH; Caroline, wife, age 44 OH, born Oct 1855, married 15 yrs, 2 children/2 still living, father born OH, mother born France; Mary, daughter, age 15 OH, born May 1885; Estella, daughter, age 9 OH, born Mar 1891.

Daughter Mary's Death Record in Ohio, File # 28819, Mary RIES, of 413 E. South St, Akron, died 19 Apr 1937 at St. Thomas Hospital, Akron, Summit Co OH. She was born 2 May 1885 in OH. Married. Parents were Frank J. STOTLER and Caroline WHITMAN, born OH. Burial Doylestown. Informant Harry W. RIES of 413 E. South St.
