

## Company G, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

WILSON, Simon P.\* 22 Aug 1862  
Simon, age 18, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 263 as a private. Simon **died** 29 Jan 1863 at Memphis, Tennessee. The Roll of Honor in the back of the Roster book lists Simon as being interred at Memphis TN in the Mississippi River Cemetery.

Cemetery: Mississippi River Cemetery, Memphis TN [Memphis National Cemetery] not listed. However, Simon's name is on a stone in St. Michael's Lutheran Cemetery, Section 3, , Baughman Twp, Wayne Co OH. His parents were Samuel and Margaret. Wayne Co Graves Registration Cards book: Simon P. Wilson of Co G 120th, died 29 Jan 1863 at Memphis TN. He was born 24 June 1843.

1850 Census for Chippewa Township Wayne County OH, page 247: Samuel Wilson (age 35, born PA) a farmer. Margaret (30 OH), Simon (6 OH), Mary A. (4 OH), Rebecca J. (1 OH).

[Note: Wayne County Probate Court record: Samuel WILSON married Margaret WEYGANDT on 24 Aug 1843 in Wayne Co OH.]

1860 census for Chippewa Township, Wayne Co OH, page 380: Samuel Willson (46 PA) a farmer, Margaret (40 OH), Simon (15 OH) a farm hand and in school, Mary A (14 OH), Rebecca J (11 OH), Nancy E. (9 OH), John F (7 OH), Thomas?[Thomanse] PRATER (27 England) a tailor. [Note: Nancy Ellen ECKI born 3 Oct 1851 Wayne Co OH, died 22 Apr 1914 in Orrville. Death record verifies father Samuel WILSON and mother Catherine WEYGANDT.]

Wooster Republican, 1 Jan 1863: Listed S. P. WILSON's residence as Chippewa.

Simon was on the list of "wounded and sick" in the Wooster Republican on 29 Jan 1863. He was in No. 3 Hospital, Adam's Block, Memphis TN. [note: He was listed as J P Wilson of Company G, 120th]
