ANDREWS, Moses 21 Aug 1862
Moses, age 37, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 264, as a Private [Hardesty's Richland: "For good soldierly conduct Mr. Andrews was promoted to corporal at Covington, Kentucky, September 16, 1862.], reduced from Corporal 28 Dec 1862; transferred to Co. K, 114th OVI 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co E, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 14 Oct 1865.

Moses transferred to Company E of the 48th Ohio Veterans Volunteer Infantry.

From [Hardesty's Richland](#), page 482: "Moses Andrews was born in Worthington township, Richland county, Ohio, September 12, 1823, a son of Moses and Patience (Capes) Andrews. His first wife was Hannah (Dickson) Andrews. He married for the second time at Independence [Richland county], Ohio, March 22, 1866, Hannah Rogers, born in Somerset county, Pennsylvania, April 11, 1882*, the daughter of Levi and Christina (Beal) Uhl. Their family consists of two daughters, Elnora and Elizabeth, and one son, James Henry. Mr Andrews' occupation is that of carpenter at Independence, Richland county, Ohio." [Note: *There seems to be a mistake in the date of Hanna Rogers' birth in the book.

1850 Census, Worthington Twp, Richland Co OH, Dwelling 310, Family 314: Moses ANDREWS, age 25 OH, farmer; Hannah, age 24 OH; Cornelia, age one OH.

1860 Census, Worthington Twp, Richland County OH, page 170: Moses ANDREWS, age 36 OH, carpenter; Hannah, age 35 OH; Ellenora, age 8 OH; James, age 4 OH.

Moses ANDREWS married Hannah ROGERS 22 Mar 1866

1870 Census Worthington Twp, Richland County OH, page 417: Moses ANDREWS, age 46 OH, carpenter; Hannah, age 38 PA; Mary L ROGERS, age 10 OH. Living in the next dwelling is James ANDREWS, age 14 OH, farm laborer. Also living next dwelling are Adam MYERS and Sarah MYERS, and child Thomas B MYERS.

1880 Census, Independence, Richland County OH, page 280: Moses ANDREWS, age 56 OH, carpenter, parents born OH; Hannah, wife, age 48 PA, parents born PA.

1890 Veterans Schedule: Worthington, Richland Co OH: Line 1, House 326, Family 335: Moses ANDREWS, Pvt, Co E, 48th OH Inf. Post Office: Butler, OH. Disability: varicose veins.

[Richland Indigent Soldier Burials 1885-1896](#): Moses ANDREWS, Company H 120th OVI, carpenter, place of death Butler, died 31 Jan 1896, buried Butler Cemetery.
