BEVERIDGE, John 21 Aug 1862

John, age 31, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 264, as a Private. He was **wounded** 12 July 1863 in battle Jackson Miss.; **captured** 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point, on Red River LA; mustered out 6 July 1865 at Camp Chase OH.

cemetery in Monroe Township, Richland County, OH. Nearby is buried Luie. His stone shows that he is son of J. and E.A.Beveridge. The cemetery book says that Luie died 21 Oct 1873 at age 9 months 14 dys. Their other 3 children were Oliver, [born 12 Dec 1860], Ira [b 12 Nov 1867], and Maud [b May 31, 1870]. Little Lewis, whose stone I found near John's stone, was born 8 Jan 1873.

Pension Index: John BEVERIDGE, H 120th OH Inf. Invalid filed 1874 Dec 26, Application 198582, Certificate 151583. Widow Elizabeth A BEVERIDGE filed 1891 May 8, Application 514862, Certificate, 364831, filed in OH.

1850 Census, Montgomery, Ashland County, OH, page 425: John BEVERAGE, age 16 Scotland, a tailor. He is living with the Laban and Jane BURGAN family. Laban is also a tailor.

Married Julia MCKAHAN or MCKAHN on 6 Sep 1853. Listed in [Early Ashland County marriages](#). Julia is buried at [Mifflin Cemetery](#), Ashland Co OH, died 1854, age 31.

Married Fayette GRAFF, 23 Aug 1855. Listed in [Early Ashland County marriages](#).

From Richland County Marriages: John BEVERAGE married Elizabeth A. BUNTON 15 Mar 1859. This was his third wife.

1860 Census, Worthington Twp, Richland County, OH, page 179: John BEVERIDGE, age 29 Scotland, tailor; Elizabeth, age 23 OH; Barbara WALLACE, age 16 OH, a domestic.

1870 Census, Worthington Twp, Richland County, OH, page 412: John BEVERAGE, age 39 Scotland, work in tailor shop; Elizabeth, age 33 OH; Alvan, age 9 OH; Ira, age 2 OH; Maud E, age 1 month OH, born in May.

1880 Census, Worthington Twp, Richland County, OH, page 261: John BEVERAGE, age 48 Scotland, tailor, parents born Scotland; Elizabeth, wife, age 41 OH, father born PA, mother born OH; Oliver, son, age 19 OH, teaching school; Ira, son, age 12 OH; Maud, daughter, age 10 OH.

1890 Veterans Schedule: Worthington Twp, Richland Co OH: Line 12, House 77, Family 78: John BEVERAGE, Pvt, Co H 120 OH Inf. : Post Office Newville, OH/ Heart and lung trouble.

There is a bio online of John BEVERIDGE which was taken from The History of Richland County, Ohio. It states that he was born in Clare county Scotland 27 Mar 1831. His parents were John and Catherine BEVERIDGE. He married Julia, daughter of John MCKAHAN. They had twins who died. He married his second wife, Fayette GRAFF, on Aug. 23, 1855. With her he had a daughter, Catherine, who died. [Boy and girl twins buried at [Mifflin Cemetery](#), Ashland Co OH, 11 Jul 185*]. His third wife was Elizabeth BUNTON, daughter of Joseph and Jane BUNTON, whom he married on 15 Mar 1859. With this wife he had four children: Oliver, Ira and Maud, but doesn't give Lewis' name. John was a tailor.
