

## Company H, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

BISEL, Eli C \* 21 Aug 1862

Eli, age 21, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 264, as a Private. He **died** 13 Feb 1863 at Young's Point LA. The Roll of Honor in the back of the Roster book says that Eli Bisel was buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi. But he is not listed at the site for Vicksburg National cemetery so he is probably buried as an unknown.

According to the letter from Captain Taylor, Eli C. Bisel was from East Union Township.

Cemetery: Vicksburg National Cemetery, MS [Not listed at Nationwide Gravesite Locator at Dept. of Veterans Affairs.] Probably buried there as an unknown.
