BRICKER, Leslie G (\*) 15 Sept 1862

Leslie, age 18, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 264, as a Private. He was discharged 20 April 1863, at Milliken's Bend, LA, on Surgeon's certificate of disability

The actual stone is knocked over.

Relationship: Brother of Joseph W. BRICKER of Co H, 120th OVI

Leslie G. died 21 May 1863. He was 18 years, 4 months and 7 days. He had been released from service on 20 April 1863 so apparently he made it home before he died. There is no listing of burial for him in the Roster book. He is buried in Old Hill Cemetery [near the water tower] in Smithville with John and Anna Bricker, and Joseph and Elizabeth Bricker.

Grave Registration Card: Leslie G BRICKER died 21 May 1863. Born 4 Jan 1845. Co H 120th OVI.

Not found in Pension Index.

1850 Census, Monroe Twp, Cumberland County, PA, page 245: George W BRICHER, age 34 PA, no occupation; Susan, age 33 PA; Joseph, age 7 PA [See soldier above]; Lessla [male] age 5 PA; Margret BIRTLE, age 19 PA.

1860 Census, Green Twp, Wayne County, OH, page 40: George BREAKER, age 46 PA, farmer; Susan, age 43 PA; Joseph, age 17 PA; Leslie, age 15 PA; George, age 7 PA; Daniel WILSON, age 9 NY
